## **NOTICE OF RACE**

**The Notice of Race is deleted and replaced in its entirety by the following:**

### **1 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY**

The Red Flannels Regatta is organized by Chicago Corinthian Yacht Club in conjunction with the CCYC Laser Fleet.

### **2 RULES**

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any amendments thereto.
- 2.2 Class Rules - Boats racing in an approved One Design Section shall be subject to their Class Rules. If there is a difference between a Class Rule, this Notice of Race (NOR) or the Sailing Instructions (SI), the more restrictive rule shall apply.
- 2.3 Class rules prohibiting the use of marine band radios and cellular telephones will not apply. All keelboats are required to carry an operating VHF marine-band radio while sailing in these events. ***This changes International Etchells Class Rules C.5.1(b).***
- 2.4 Keelboat crews must consist of 2 or more persons. ***This changes J/70 class rule C.3.1(a) and Etchells Class Rule C.2.1 (a).***
- 2.5 For the purposes of Section 2.3, 2.4, and 14 of this Notice of Race, Keelboats are defined as Tartan 10, J/70, Etchells, and Sonars.
- 2.6 All applicable governmental regulations regarding health, safety and infectious disease control shall be strictly followed by all competitors, specifically including any crew limits and requirements for personal protective equipment (PPE).
- 2.7 Violations of Section 2.6 of this Notice of Race shall not be protestable by a competitor but may be protested by the Race Committee or Organizing Authority. ***This changes rule RRS 60.1.***

2.8 Due to COVID restrictions, only cars with Montrose mooring passes are allowed into the harbor.

A transient slip day pass can be procured through the Harbormaster.

4.1 Eligibility for entry shall be in accordance with the respective Class Rules, which apply in their entirety.

4.2 Other than Lasers, Yachts must hold a valid Measurement Certificate.

4.3 All sails shall have Official Royalty Labels.

4.4 The regatta is open to the following One Design Fleets:

International Laser Class

Rhodes 19 Class

Vanguard 15 Class

Tartan Ten Class

International J70 Class

Etchells Class

Sonar Class

The Race Chairperson may adjust the racing schedule to suit weather conditions. The Race Committee will try to run as many races in a given day as possible and will not start a race after 1400 on Sunday.

## **6 RACING AREAS**

- 6.1 Race Area A will be sailed in the general area of CCYC Race Area, East or Northeast of CCYC on Lake Michigan and will be based out of Montrose Harbor.
- 6.2 Race Area B will be sailed in the area East of Belmont Shoal Buoy and will be based out of Belmont Harbor.

## **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

## **8 COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be provided in the sailing instructions.

## **9 SCORING**

- 9.1 One completed race will constitute a regatta.
- 9.2 A boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. No score will be discarded. ***This changes RRS A2.***

## **10 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones or any devices that use cellular or wireless technology.

## **11 PROPULSION (OTHER THAN LASERS):**

RRS 42.2 (a) shall be altered to read: "On a free leg of the course, when surfing (rapidly accelerating down the leeward side of a wave) or planing is possible, the yacht's crew may, in order to initiate surfing or planing, pump the sheet, but not the guy, controlling any sail, but only once for each wave of gust of wind. When the mainsail is pumped, only that part of the sheet between the crew member handling the sheet and the first block on the boom shall be used".

## **12 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given to the top three boats in each class.

## **13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustain in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta.

## **14 INSURANCE**

Each participating keelboat, as defined in 2.5, shall be adequately insured with valid third-party liability insurance that is appropriate taking into account the value of the boats racing and the type of racing.
