1. Rules

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the *rules* defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2021 - 2024)
- 1.2 Racing Rule A2.1 will be changed as follows: No score will be excluded.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 Eligibility is limited to women only. All skippers and crew must be women.

3. Proposed Classes

- 3.1 PHRF, Portsmouth, J22, Sunfish, Laser, Flying Scot.
- 3.2 Three (3) boats of a class or of a similar PHRF/Portsmouth rating may constitute a fleet.
- 3.3 Fleets will be announced at the competitors meeting.

4. Sailing Instructions

- 4.1 Sailing Instructions will be posted to Regatta Network by September 16, 2022

5. Entries

- 5.1 Online registrations are made via Regatta Network.
- 5.2 Entry Fee \$30.00 for single handed boats. \$40.00 for boats with 2 or more crew.
\$10 Youth Skippers (age 21 and younger).
- 5.3 The deadline for registering and paying the entry fee is September 23rd, 2022 at 10:00 P.M.
- 5.4 The entry fee includes: racing, trophies, dinner/celebration for skippers and crew, and a SEW-MAD shirt for each skipper. Additional shirts are available for ordering through Regatta Network at registration time. Additional shirts will be available for purchase at the event while supplies last.

6. Schedule

- 10:00 A.M. Check-in** - white tent in the LCYC parking lot.
- 11:30 A.M. Competitors Briefing** - white tent in the LCYC parking lot.
- 1:30 P.M. First Signal** - on the water.
- 6:00 P.M. Dinner, Awards, and Celebration.** - LCYC Clubhouse

7. Scoring

- 7.1 A boat's score will be the total of her race scores with no throw-outs.
- 7.2 One (1) race constitutes a Regatta.
- 7.3 The number and type of races will be scheduled subject to competitor input.

8. Courses

- 8.1 The course(s) to be raced will be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

9. Prizes

- 9.1 Prizes will be awarded to all competitors.
- 9.2 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- 9.3 The SEW-MAD Perpetual trophies will be awarded to the skippers with the lowest cumulative score in the largest keelboat and boardboat fleets.
