Dear Log Canoe Skipper,

We are pleased to welcome you to the Cambridge Yacht Club for the 83rd Anniversary of the first Governor Hicks Trophy for Log Canoes. Enclosed are your "Sailing Instructions" and the "Schedule of Events". What follows is an attempt to answer the likely questions you may have about the race weekend. First and foremost... **docking is free, water is free, the beer wagon is free, and the ice is free.**

This year we have chosen to host the Hamptons National Championship on the same weekend as your event. As a result, the CYC grounds will be busier than usual. The Hamptons competitors have exclusive access to certain areas of the club, and we do respectfully ask the log canoe competitors to be mindful.

Saturday's events begin with a short Skipper's Meeting at 0830hrs in our gazebo where coffee and donuts will be provided courtesy of the Race Chair. Our Gazebo opens at noon and, following race #1, we will be cooking hamburgers, served with chips and a soda, at a cost of \$12 which includes tax and a small tip. In celebration of the weekend, donors have provided free beer to the Log Canoers - you can find it at the beer wagon. The bar will also be open for those who wish something stronger to drink. If you and your crew wish to purchase lunch from the Gazebo we would appreciate receiving a head count at the skippers meeting Saturday morning.

Saturday evening we will have live music playing on the lawn sometime near 1700hrs. Dinner service will be available at the Club House, but reservations are required and so is a collared shirt. Check out the menu at <http://www.cambridgeyachtclub.com>. Sunday's race will be immediately followed by additional celebrations at the gazebo and recognition of awards.

As a reminder, we have four 50 ft. foot slips and ten 60 ft. slips available. The slip widths are 22.5 ft. for the 50 and 25 ft. for the 60. These are the same slips competitors used in prior CYC regattas. Feel free to stage your boats at CYC during the week of the 15th - please communicate your needs to the Race Chair in advance.
