5 PHRF & MARSHALL 18 COURSES

- 5.1 **COURSES** will be signaled from the crow's nest of the club. Letters A through F correspond to Marks shown on the course chart. The order of the Letters designate the course. The Marks shall be rounded in the order posted with the color of the letter indicating the side on which Marks are to be rounded.
- 5.2 **COURSE MARKS** will be a combination of BBYC orange and white barrels and government buoys.

Club Marks A, B, H are orange and white barrels.

Government Marks are:

C is Red #6 D is Red # 4 E is Red # 2 F is Green #1

5.3 Races will be started using RRS 26.

- 5.4 **START AND FINISH** will be between an orange cylinder on the dock and Mark A.
- 5.5 **SHORTEN COURSE** shall be signaled before with Race Flag "S" displayed with two sound signals before the first boat finishes between Mark A and the orange cylinder on the dock.

5.6 **RACE TIME LIMIT** is 1¹/₂ hour for the first boat to start, sail the course, and finish. The Finishing Window is 15 minutes for boats finishing after the first boat finishes. Boats not finishing will be scored TLE. This changes RRS 35 and A 2.1.

6 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 6.1 The Protest Time Limit is 1 hour after the last PHRF boat finishes, or 1 hour after the respective Race Committee boat docks for the day. The time will be posted on the Official Notice Board.
