

2023 Labor Day Regatta

September 2-3, 2023

The organizing authority is the Augusta Sailing Club.

Rules: Racing is governed by the USSA RACING RULES OF SAILING for 2021-2024, USSA Prescriptions, individual class rules, and Sailing Instructions (SI available online and posted outside of the ASC clubhouse).

Classes Expected: Open Skiff, ICLA 4, ILCA 6, ILCA 7, Sunfish, C Scow, MC Scow, E Scow, Y Flyer, Portsmouth: PHRF Spin and Non-Spin.

Classes of four or more will sail and be scored as a class. Miscellaneous dinghies will sail and be scored within the Portsmouth fleet. PHRF fleets will be scored Time on Time.

Marks will be designated in the competitors meeting and posted on the committee boat. Open Skiffs will have their own start with a three minute start sequence.

The low point scoring system Rule A-2 will apply, modified so that each boat's score shall be the total of her race scores in all races. If 6 or more races are scored, each boat will exclude her worst score. One race will constitute a regatta. If a race "times out" the boats not finishing the race in the time allotted will be scored one point more than the number of boats finishing in the time allowed.

Fees: Base entry fee for the Regatta is \$20 per boat, Junior skippers < 18 years of age \$10

Registration: Registration will be on-line only and will close at 9am, Saturday, September 2nd. ASC has adopted an online registration and payment system. Payment is made at the time of registration via the Club Web Portal. Please register early.

Schedule: A competitors skippers meeting will be held 10:00 AM at the ASC Clubhouse on Saturday, September 2^{nd} . The race start sequence will begin no earlier than 12:00 PM Sunday, September 3^{rd} racing continues starting at 12:00 PM.

Courses: Courses will be described at the Saturday skippers meeting and posted on the Signal boat.

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the top finishers in each fleet on Sunday, September 3rd.
