



Channel Islands to Marina del Rey Race Saturday, Sept. 23, 2023 Presented by Del Rey YC and Channel Islands YC NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- **1.1** The event is governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and PHRF of Southern California (PHRF SoCal) Class Rules, which are available at phrfsocal.org.
- **1.2** Rules 51 and 52 are modified to allow positioning of movable ballast and use of powered winches when so rated by PHRF SoCal.
- **1.3** Rule 47 is modified to allow biodegradable sail stops when setting a sail.
- 2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIs): Will be posted on the official online notice board.

3. COMMUNICATION

- **3.1** The official notice board is located online at dryc.org. On race day the notice board will be near the main entrance of the Channel Islands Yacht Club (CIYC).
- **3.2** All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on domestic channels.
- **3.3** [DP] All boats shall carry a smart phone with email and texting capabilities.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **4.1** The event is open to boats possessing a current PHRF SoCal certificate.
- 4.2 There will be two divisions: Performance and Cruiser.
- **4.3** Eligible boats shall enter by filling out the online entry form available at dryc.org/racing. Late entries will be accepted only if approved by the Race Committee (RC), and the entry fee will be increased by 25%.
- 5. FEES: The entry fee is a function of boat length and payable at the time of entry

6. CLASSES

6.1 Classes within each division will be based on ratings and the number of entries.

6.2 The RC reserves the right to reassign a boat from a Cruiser class to a Performance class.

7. SCHEDULE

8. VENUE: The Santa Barbara Channel and Santa Monica Bay. The race distance is approximately 45 nm from Channel Islands Harbor to Marina del Rey. In the event of light winds, a shorter course may be signaled.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 Boats will be scored using their PHRF Off Wind Course (OWC) Ratings.
- **9.2** Performance Division boats' ratings shall not include any of the Configuration Adjustments in Appendix F of the PHRF SoCal Class Rules.
- **9.3** Performance boats may not use a Non-Spinnaker Offset, and only qualifying Cruiser Division boats may use a Non-Spinnaker Offset (PHRF SoCal Appendix C5.0).
- **10. BERTHING**: Limited docking will be available at CIYC and DRYC. Advanced reservations are required. See Competitor Information.
- **11. RISK STATEMENT**: RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

12. HOSPITALITY

- **12.1** CIYC welcomes all visiting boats to Channel Islands Harbor for the race start and will help with guest berthing. CIYC invites all racers to its clubhouse for Friday Happy Hour, steak dinner (veggie option) with DJ entertainment, and a hearty breakfast Saturday morning.
- **12.2** DRYC welcomes visiting and returning racers to the race finish in Marina del Rey. Guest berthing may be available, and DRYC will host a continental breakfast with the post race awards presentation.
- **12.3** Advance RSVP is necessary for guest berthing and events. See Competitor Information.

13. PRIZES

- **13.1** Individual prizes will be awarded based on the number of entries in each class and division.
- **13.2** Perpetual trophies will be presented at the awards ceremony.
