NOTICE OF RACE

Published July 17, 2024

1. <u>RULES</u>

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing for* 2021-2024.
- 1.2 Each sailor is required to wear a life jacket and shoes. Shoes must be worn while sailing and launching or retrieving your boat due to oyster shells.
- 1.3 All competitors, parents, coaches, or other parties of interest are expected to comply with all rules of sportsmanship (RRS) and the SAYRA Junior Championship Committee "<u>Code of Ethics</u>". Violation on their part may result in the competitor's disqualification from the race, regatta, or Series and reporting to their member club.
- 1.4 The SAYRA Junior Grand Prix Championship Series NOR "<u>SAYRA NOR</u>" is referenced and to be adhered to for this event. In case of conflict in NORs the SAYRA NOR shall prevail.
- 1.5 All boats shall have sail numbers on both sides of the sail.
- 1.6 All boats shall give way to law enforcement and commercial traffic such as barges.
- 1.7 ICW marker 242 (across from the club) shall not be passed on the western side due to obstructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The event is open to the following classes of Juniors:
 - 2.1.1 ILCA 7 (Under 21), ILCA 6 (Under 19), ILCA 4 (Under 18)
 - 2.1.2 C420 (Under 19): Non-Spin or Trap may compete but must start and be scored with C420.
 - 2.1.3 Sunfish Junior (Under 19)
 - 2.1.4 O'Pen Skiff (Under 13), O'Pen Skiff (13+)
 - 2.1.5 Optimist RWB (White ten or under, Blue 11-12, Red 13-15)
 - 2.1.6 Optimist Green (novice under 15)
 - 2.1.7 All age requirements are through 2024, except Opti White and Blue, whose skippers change fleets on their birthdays, unless their birthday falls during this regatta.

3. <u>ENTRY</u>

- 3.1 THERE WILL BE NO ON-SITE REGISTRATION OR PAYMENT. All registrations must be completed and paid for on Regatta Network.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing their registration at: <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/27085</u>. After September 5, registration and payment will be charged a \$10 late fee.
- 3.3 Registrations **are not complete** <u>*until paid*</u> for on Regatta Network.
- 3.4 All sailors are required to visit the check-in table in the BYSC clubhouse before 10:00 am, September 7th, to verify registration information, confirm the sail number, and pick up lunches.

4. <u>FEES</u>

- 4.1 Registration costs \$50 per boat skipper and \$35 per crew, including breakfast and lunch daily.
- 4.2 A \$5 discount will be applied for US Sailing members.
- 4.3 Guests will become temporary members of BYSC upon registration.
- 4.4 If you register before August 15, you can buy event shirts at a discounted price on Regatta Network. Some shirts will be available on-site, while they last, during the event.

5. <u>MEALS</u>

- 5.1 Continental breakfast will be provided each day.
- 5.2 All registered sailors will receive a Box Lunch on Saturday and Sunday.
- 5.3 Meals for *Families and Support Teams* see 16.3.

6. <u>SCHEDULE</u>

- 6:00-9:00 Pool party and social event
- 6.2 Sunday, September 8, 2024.
 - 8:30-9:30 Continental breakfast & Lunch pick-up
 - 9:00 Coaches Meeting
 - 10:00 Warning for 1st race. Other races to follow.
 - No race warning signal will be given after 2:00 pm.
 - Awards will be presented around 3:30 pm after racing and any protest resolution.

7. <u>SCORING</u>

- 7.1 One race completed for each class will constitute a regatta.
- 7.2 The regatta will be scored using the low point system described in RRS, Appendix A, as amended to read that if *six or more races* are scored, each boat will exclude her worst score.
- 7.3 There is no maximum number of races.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 8.1 Available online at <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/27085</u> no later than September 2, 2024, and at the Official Notice Board on the BYSC riverside porch. Print your copy before arrival. In the case of a conflict between this NOR and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.
- 9. <u>COURSES</u> There will be two race circles with the following possible classes.
 - 9.1 The South Circle are planned to be the Optimist RWB, Optimist Green, and O'Pen Skiff courses. The courses will be trapezoid with a mid-leg start and finish line and a short weather mark for the Optimist Green Fleet.
 - 9.2 The North Circle are planned to be the ILCA 4, ILCA 6, ILCA 7, Sunfish, and 420 courses. The courses will be windward/leeward, or a triangle course may be used.
 - 9.3 Courses will be described in more detail in the Sailing Instructions.
 - 9.4 Classes may be shifted to other circles if deemed necessary.

- 10. SAILBOATS FOR RENT. BCSB has 420s, O'Pen Skiffs, Optimists, and Sunfish, which may be available for rent. The 420s do not have spinnakers or traps. Contact Noah Kipar, our sailing director, (see paragraph 18) for further information. A Rental Agreement is required to be signed by a parent or guardian on behalf of the sailor.
- 11. <u>DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY.</u> Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See *RRS Rule 3. Decision to Race.* The Organizing Authority and Co-Sponsor will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, before, during, or after the regatta.
- **12.** <u>AWARDS</u>. Prizes will be presented to the top three boats in each class except for Opti Green sailors, who will all receive Participation Awards.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

13. RAMP LAUNCHING AND RETRIEVING FOR ROAD TRAILERS

- 13.1 Safe launching for road trailers is usually 3 hours before or after high tide.
- 13.2 Tides for Beaufort/BYSC
 - Friday: high tide at 11:54 pm.
 - Saturday: high tide at 12:12 pm, low tide at 6:18 am & 6:44 pm
 - Sunday: high tide at 12:50 pm, low tide at 6:59 am & 7:28 pm.
- 13.3 Other information.
 - Dollies are not to be left at the water's edge after launching due to congestion and the tide.

14. COACH AND SPECTATOR BOATS

- 14.1 The PRO of the respective courses shall restrict Coach and spectator boats to certain areas.
- 14.2 All coach boats shall be issued and fly an identification flag, available at the check-in desk.
- 14.3 All support vessels shall be equipped with a functioning engine safety cut-out switch (kill switch) which shall always remain attached to the operator while the engine runs.

15. VHF RADIOS

- 15.1 All RC boats, coach boats, spectator boats, and other visitors on the water must have functioning VHF radios. Please monitor the signal boat channel on the circle you are following.
- 15.2 As a courtesy, the Race Committee may announce relevant information or call OCS's. Failure to hear transmissions from the Race Committee, the timing, or the sequence of calling of OCSs shall not be a cause for redress.
- 15.3 VHF channels to be used will be detailed in the Sailing instructions.

16. CLUB AMENITIES.

- 16.1 The pool and tennis/pickleball courts are open to regatta guests during regular club hours.
- 16.2 Additional T-shirts may be purchased at <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/27085</u>.
- 16.3 At the event, our Knotly Crew from BCSB will host an "Old Fashioned Cookout" where you can enjoy hamburgers and hot dogs with all the fixings. This event costs \$6 and will be available Saturday and Sunday lunchtime starting at 11:00am. Payment methods will be Venmo or Credit Card.

On Saturday the club will host a **Lowcounty Boil** (boiled shrimp, corn on the cob, potatoes, and sausage) with all the fixings. You can pre-purchase a meal during registration or online at <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/27085</u>. Tickets purchased online before the regatta are \$18 for adults and \$10 for competitors and children). Meals purchased Saturday are \$20 for adults and \$12 for competitors and children.

An ice cream truck will also be available on-site on Saturday afternoon starting at 3:00 pm. Vendor will accept cash and Venmo as payment methods.

- 16.4 Limited electrical hookups are available upon request. A bathhouse (with showers) near the pool is open.
- 16.5 NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON CLUB GROUNDS.
- 16.6 Camping is available on the club ground. Please check in with the General Manager for preplanned camping locations.
- 16.7 Most hotel chains are represented in the Beaufort area, as well as numerous BandBs.
- 16.8 On-site trailer, coach boat, and vehicle parking are provided all weekend

17. DIRECTIONS TO BYSC.

- 17.1 From the north: follow Rt 21 south, follow Bus. 21 through downtown Beaufort and over the Wood's Memorial swing bridge. Take the first right onto Meridian Rd., across from the boat ramp. In approximately 1 mile, turn right on Yacht Club Drive.
- 17.2 From the south: follow SC 170 over the Broad River Bridge, and in ¼ mile, turn right onto SC 128. In one mile turn right onto Rt. 21 at the stoplight. Go to the third stoplight with Hardees, CVS, Advance Auto Parts, and a gas station on the corners. Turn right and proceed over McTeer Bridge. In ½ mile, turn left onto Meridian Dr., and in approximately 1 mile, turn left onto Yacht Club Drive.
