1. RULES

1.1 This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 Rule 44.2 is changed: If an incident occurs outside the zone of a rounding or finishing mark, rule 44.2 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND CLASSES

2.1 Skipper/Entrant must be a member in good standing of South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club.

2.2 There will be one non- spinnaker class. Boats may opt to use their non-spin ratings. Random leg ratings will be used. For boats without a rating the RC will assign a rating.

ENTRY AND FEES

3.1 The entry fee is \$15.

3.2 Entry forms must be submitted no later than the skippers meeting

5. SKIPPERS MEETING

Skippers meeting will be held at SCCYC at 1030 the day of the race. This is a pursuit race and start times for all boats will be issued at this meeting.

6. VENUE / COURSE

6.1 Start will be between the committee boat and the light at the south entrance of MDR breakwater.

6.2 Proceed to Santa Monica pier, round to starboard orange buoy at approximately 34 00.41N 118 30.3W. Return to MDR via north entrance and proceed to finish observing all no-sail buoys.

6.3 Finish will be between the committee boat and yellow buoy marked A in main channel.

6.4 TIME LIMIT

Boats not finishing by 1600 will be scored as Did Not Finish (DNF). This changes rule 35.

7. PROTESTS

There should be no protests of any significance.

9. **COMMUNICATIONS**

The RC will monitor VHF channel 68.

10. **TROPHIES**

Trophies will be awarded at SCCYC following the race.
