Storage	immediately to the South and East of the Lions Club. All trailers will
	be stored in the Gulfport Marina parking lot. Boats must launch
	from GYC beach. Boats and trailers must be removed following
	racing on Sunday, March 19.

14.0 Parking	Parking is available for cars outside the main entrance of GYC or the Gulfport Marina parking lot. Vehicles parked blocking GYC members' boats, or interfering with access to the beach will be towed. All trailers are to be stored in the marina parking lot adjacent to the club. Please check-in with the volunteer parking attendant.
