## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **Duke Kahanamoku Classic**

### **August 18, 2024**

#### **1. RULES:**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Hawaii Yacht Racing Association Season Points Notice of Series, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
  - 1.2.1. Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches.
  - 1.2.2. Rule 52 is modified to allow the use of autopilot for doubled and single-handed racers only.
  - 1.2.3. Rule 55 is changed to allow the use of banding for safety purposes.

**2. ADVERTISING:** Advertising will not be restricted.

#### **3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:**

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the classes: X, A, B, Cruiser, Cal 20, and multihull with skippers who are members of HYRA member clubs.
- 3.2. Yachts will race and be scored if there are 3 or more entries
- 3.3. Eligible boats shall enter by registering on Regatta Network by the skippers meeting: [Duke Kahanamoku Regatta : Waikiki Yacht Club \(regattanetwork.com\)](#)

**4. FEES:** The entry fee up to 24hr of start will be \$55.00 for PHRF, \$10.00 for Cal 20s. Late registration (within 24hr of start): \$65.00.

#### **5. SCHEDULE:**

- 5.1. Regatta Network registration closes at 1000 HST on August 18, 2024
- 5.2. Skippers' Meeting: 1000 HST August 18, 2024
- 5.3. First Warning: 1155 HST August 18, 2024
- 5.4. Number of Races: All fleets will have up to three buoy races

**6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and on Regatta Network

**7. VENUE:** The Course Area will off the south shore of Oahu

**8. COURSES:** Courses will be displayed by the Race Committee at or prior to the warning of the race as described in the Sailing Instructions

**9. SCORING:** The scoring system is as follows:

- 9.1. X, A, B, and Cruising will use PHRF Handicap rating systems as endorsed by HYRA
- 9.2. Multi and Cal 20s will use The Low Point Scoring System

**10. PRIZES:** Prizes will be presented at the awards ceremony
