Venue

Boats will be launched off McGee Beach, adjacent to the host hotel. Racing will be on Corpus Christi Bay, East of McGee Beach.

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Formula Wave Class rules apply.

All Sails must be measured or previously certified. All sails must be submitted for event id.

The fleet will be split in 2 if 41+ boats attend, and into 3 fleets if 81+. The event will consist of a qualifying series (first 2 days) and finals series (final 2 days) split into Gold and Silver (and Bronze if 81+).

US Sailing medals will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in the Gold Fleet.

Winning competitor will be named US Sailing Multihull Champion and will have their name placed on the HOBIE ALTER CUP Trophy.

Awards will also be given to top finishers in the Silver Fleet.
