The decision to race or to abandon the race on Saturday will be made on Friday. We are looking carefully at the predicted path of Tropical Storm Debbie as it moves up the coast this week and at the local weather forecast for Saturday. An amendment to the NOR has been posted to take into account the possibility in the event it is advisable to abandon the race for reasons of safety.

The awards party will still take place at Bell & Anchor on Sat evening from 5:30-8:30 and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place grand prizes will be drawn as a raffle, live at the event by the Minister of Tourism, Honorable Charles "Max" Fernandez. All registered Captains MUST be in attendance in order for their boat to be entered into the raffle.

NOR Amendment 1

Paragraph 3 AWARDS is modified as follows.

If racing is abandoned *on the water on August 10* through lack of wind or other causes, the winners of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Overall prizes will be determined by a drawing that will take place at the post-race party; the name of each boat that entered the race and checked in with the Race Committee on the water will be entered in the draw. In order to win, the boat name drawn must have a representative present at the drawing.

If racing is abandoned prior to August 10, the winners of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Overall prizes will be determined by a drawing that will take place at the post-race party; the name of each boat that entered the race and checked in with the Race Committee on the water will be entered in the draw. In order to win, the captain of the boat name drawn must be present at the drawing.
