Sailing Instructions

Governors Cup/ Riddle Cup June 8, 2024

Hosted By Kentucky Lake Sailing Club

1. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)

2. Entries

Competitors may enter by completing the registration and paying the entry fee at kentuckylakesailingclub.com

3. Notice to Competitors

Notice to competitors will be posted at Pier 4 Lighthouse Landing

4. Schedule and Class Flags

A competitors skippers meeting will be held at 17:00 on June 7,2024 at Pier 4 Lighthouse Landing. The first warning will be at 09:00 on June 8, 2024, there will be one race. Class Flags and order of start will be announced at the Skippers Meeting.

5. Course and Marks

The Course will be on Kentucky Lake with the start and finish across from Lighthouse Landing, approximately mile 23, between the orange flag on the Committee Boat and Orange Buoy, start and finish will be on the same side of the Committee Boat. The turning mark is the Red Nun at Pisgah Bay (36' 54.650'N - 88' 10.803'W) and

must be passed to the east side. the rounding mark is the green can at the mouth of Sugar Bay (36' 51.281'N - 88' 8.752' W).

6. Starting and Finishing

The warning signal will be at 09:00 and the start for the first class follows in 5 minutes, following classes will have a warning signal when the starting line is clear.

The class flag will go up at the warning signal, 1 minute later the I flag goes up (white with a blue square in the center). At 4 minutes the I flag goes down and at 5 minutes the class flag goes down for the start.

7. Time Limit

The Time limit for racing will be at 16:00 at which time the race will be over. The Committee Boat will return to the marina at that time.

8. Protest

Protest must be in writing and delivered to the Committee Boat on Pier 3, Lighthouse Landing within 1hour of the time the Committee Boat reaches the dock. Hearings will be held as soon as practicable.

9. Scoring

Scoring will be PHRF wind dependent time on time. Time correction = 700(F+PHRF), F=650 light wind (3-8), F=550 moderate wind (8-12), F= 450 heavy wind (13-25)

10. Communication

The Race Committee will attempt to announce on VHF channel 72 one minute before the warning signals and of any boats that are over early. The Flags will have priority over the announcements or the horn.
