

1. Rules

The Regatta is organized under the authority of J/24 Fleet 86 and Davis Island Yacht Club. This regatta will be governed by rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. Eligibility

The regatta is open to all J/24 sailboats as defined by the IJCA.

3. Entry and Fees

Boats may enter prior to the competitor's meeting by completing the online registration and paying the entry fee. Early registration in highly encouraged.

4. Schedule

Friday July 12th 1600-1800 – Check-in & Welcome

Saturday July 13th

0900 – Check-in 1000 - Competitors' Meeting 1200 - First warning signal 1800 - Social Event - Downstairs

Sunday July 14th

1000 - First warning signal 1300 - No warning signal after this time 1500 - Awards and social to follow

5. Measurement

All boats are subject to random inspection or measurement by the Organizing Authority at any time during the regatta for rules compliance.

6. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website and at check-in.

7. Venue

Racing will be held on Hillsborough Bay south of the DIYC Clubhouse.

8. Courses

The courses will be Windward/Leeward courses with drop marks per the Sailing Instructions.

9. Scoring

9.1 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9.2 When five or more races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for the top three finishers.

11. Logistical Support

Please contact Nadia Daggett, regatta chairman, for help with housing. First come first served. There are ample hotels and sailor Airbnbs available in the area. Boat storage can be arranged with prior approval for a few days prior to the event and a few days after.
