**NOTICE OF RACE**



**1.0 Rules:**

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the US Safety Equipment Regulations (US SER 2021.0-Nearshore), one design class rule rules, and Sailing Instructions. OYC is the organizing authority for the Oceanside Yacht Club Charity Regatta benefiting The Elizabeth Hospice of North County San Diego.

**2.0 Eligibility and Entry:**

2.1 The regatta is open to members of yacht clubs and sailing associations recognized by the Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA) or US SAILING. Yachts in the Non-Spinnaker class without a PHRF certificate will be accepted and will be assigned a rating by the race committee. The regatta is open to the following One-Design classes: Schock 35, Beneteau First 36.7, Holder 20, Capri 25, Catalina 27, J24, J80, Olson 30, J120 and yachts holding a current valid Southern California or San Diego PHRF certificate rating between -18 and 240. Other interested classes are invited to enter if they have at least 3 boats and contact Race Committee by July 10, 2024. Yachts in PHRF and One Design Classes must have a valid 2024 PHRF certificate.



2.2 Ratings: Southern California or San Diego PHRF Buoy and Random Leg Ratings will be used with area adjustments.

2.3 **Entries are due by 1700 on Wednesday, July 31.** Entry fee is \$60.00. Acceptance of late entries is at the discretion of the Race Chairman.

2.5 Classes: PHRF Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker classes will be established by the Race Committee. Non-Spinnaker class boats may not use spinnakers or gennakers.

2.6 The Marine Industry Racer (MIR) rule of PHRF of Southern California will not apply to this regatta.

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**4.0 Races and Racing Areas:**

- 4.1 Five races (3 Saturday & 2 Sunday) are scheduled for One-Design and PHRF Spinnaker classes. Three races (2 Saturday & 1 Sunday) are scheduled for Non-Spinnaker class.
- 4.2 All classes will race south of the harbor entrance.



**5.0 Sailing Instructions and Competitor's Meeting:**

- 5.1 A race packet including Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitor's meeting held at OYC on Saturday, August 3 at 1000 hrs.
- 5.2 Changes in Sailing Instructions: Any changes to this NOR or Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Race Notice Board on the OYC deck and OYC office window by 1000 hrs on race day.
- 5.3 Class Breaks, Class Flags and Order of Start: Class Breaks, Class Flags and Order of Start will be announced at the Competitor's meeting and posted on the OYC Race Notice Board by 1000 hrs on Saturday, August 3.
- 5.4 Pre-Race Check-in: All boats must check in each day with the OYC Race Committee boat when it is anchored in the starting area displaying a code "L" flag and must be recognized prior to the warning signal for the first start. Any boat failing to comply will be scored DNS.



**6.0 Scoring:**

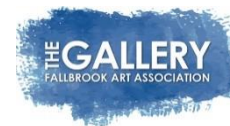
- 6.1 The Low-Point Scoring System of the RRS 2021-2024, Appendix A will apply. Two races shall constitute a series.

**7.0 Safety:**

- 7.1 All yachts entered must comply with the Monohull-SER-2023.0-Nearshore equipment and safety requirements as noted on the US Sailing website <https://www.ussailing.org/wp-content/uploads/2023/03/Monohull-SER-2023.0-Nearshore.pdf>

**8.0 Berthing:**

- 8.1 **Yachts requiring a berth must have registered online or have contacted OYC Port Captain Adam Johnson via email at [pc@oceansideyc.net](mailto:pc@oceansideyc.net) by July 31 to confirm availability.** Yachts will be docked, possibly rafted, at either the end of I-dock or the docks in the location of the former Jolly Roger Restaurant and accommodated on a first come-first served basis. Upon arrival, yachts should hail OYC on VHF Channel 68 or via phone call or text to 760-586-6902.
