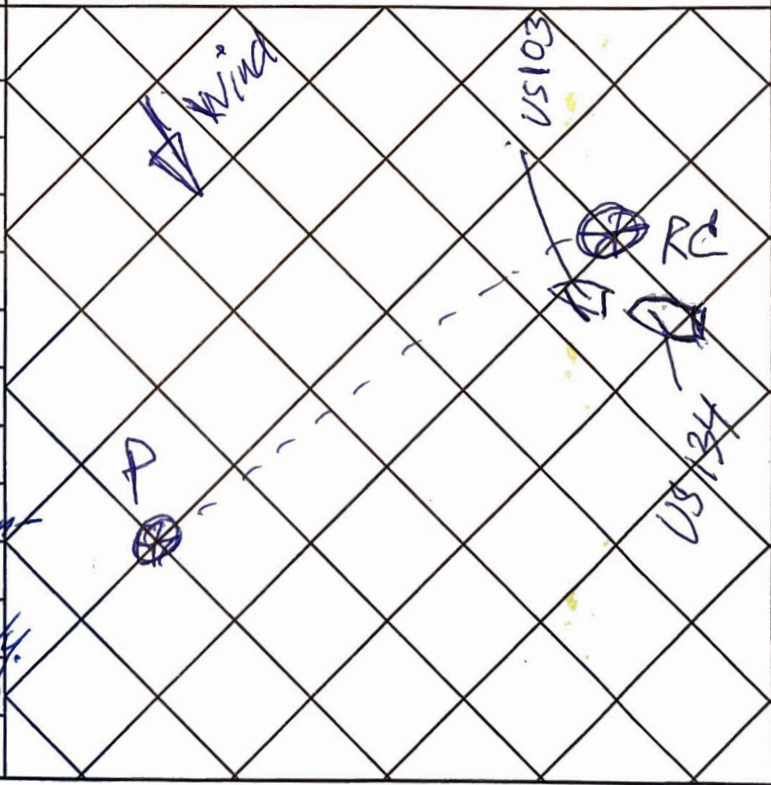

US-134 hailed US103
"to come up".
US103 responded,
"No overlap", and,
"don't hit us" twice.
US134's bow hit the
stern to the far right
of center, and did substantial
damage. US103
hailed protest immediately
and displayed protest flag
at first safe opportunity.



Contact between boats happened, 8-9 seconds before start signal.
