

# **CREW OF 2 AMENDMENT 1 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

## **4. SCHEDULE**

- 4.1. 10:55 AM First Warning;
- 4.2. 11:00 AM All boats/classes in a Single Start

## **6. START AND FINISH LINES**

- 6.1. The Start Line will be between the orange flag on the Race Committee boat and the inflatable orange tetrahedron located approximately 200 yards south of the Balboa Pier.
- 6.2. The US Sailing RRS 26, five (5) minute start sequence will be used for all boats
- 6.3. The Finish Line will be between two orange tetrahedrons approximately 200 yards off the South end of Balboa Pier. The tetrahedrons will be illuminated with LED lights for night finishes.
  
- 6.4. Boats crossing the finish line will record their own finish time. Ideally, take a picture of your GPS Clock with a tetrahedron in the background. At a minimum, text your boat name and/or sail number, finish time, Saturday or Sunday, to (678) 296-4970.

## **7. TIME LIMIT**

- 7.1. The time limit is 5:00 PM, Sunday, July 14<sup>th</sup> for the Catalina Island and Ship Rock courses. Racers must take their own finish times and call or text boat name, sail number and the finish times, Saturday or Sunday to be scored to the Race Committee at (678) 296-4970.
