NOTICE OF RACE The Kalakaua Cup July 6th, 2024

Organizing Authority: Kaneohe Yacht Club.

1 RULES:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The prescriptions of US Sailing will apply, except that US Sailing Prescription to 63.2 will not apply.
- 1.3 RRS No. 47 does not apply to spinnaker stopping materials if they are biodegradable. It still applies to trash.
- 1.4 All boats shall carry an operating VHF radio. Channel 68 will be used.
- 1.5 **ADVERTISING:** Advertising will not be restricted.

2 **ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY**:

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats whose owners/skippers are members of HYRA member clubs and who possess a valid YRA PHRF handicap for their boat's class. Multi-hulls and other boats may be invited by the organizing authority.
- 2.2 Eligible yachts should enter online at Regatta Network before Midnight July 2, 2024. The entry fee will be \$125.00 per yacht. Yachts registering after that time will pay a late fee of \$50.00.

- 2.4 A \$15.00 portion of the entry fee will be sent to HYRA for the Annual Awards event.

3 CLASSES:

- 3.1 Classes X, A, B and Aloha as defined by HYRA.
- 3.2 A Minimum of three (3) entries by 2359 on Tuesday, July 2^{nd,} 2024 will be required to establish a class.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be available after 1800 Hours, July 3rd, 2024, at KYC. To be posted shortly thereafter on Regatta Network.

6 VENUE and COURSES:

- 6.1 There will be 3 races, no throw outs, with courses held on outer Kaneohe Bay. See Sailing Instructions for additional information.
- 6.2 Access race area from Kaneohe Yacht Club from either the 'Main Ships Channel' for boats with draft over 8 Feet, or the 'Sampan Channel' for boats with less draft. Check tide charts for the day.

7 SCORING:

7.1 The YRA formula for PHRF Time On Time scoring will be used for this regatta.

- 7.2 Each boat's series score shall, subject to rule 90.3(b), be the total of her race scores. No score will be excluded. This modifies Rule A2 SERIES SCORES part A2.1
- 7.3 The boat with the lowest series score will determine the winner of the Kalakaua Cup.
- 7.4 Appendix A4 SCORING, part A4 SCORING SYSTEM will apply.

8 **BERTHING**:

- 8.1 Visiting boats, contact KYC Port Captain, Mike Barker (808) 650-4192 | kyc@kaneoheyachtclub.com at least one week prior to arrival at KYC to discuss mooring arrangements.
- 8.2 To facilitate mooring arrangements at KYC, visiting boats must provide LOA, beam and draft data on their entry form and to the KYC Port Captain.
- 9 COURSE AREA(S): Races will held on Kaneohe Bay Offshore waters adjacent and NNE of R2.
- 10 **PRIZES:** The Kalakaua Cup will be awarded at the HYRA Awards Dinner.
- 11 **BERTHING:** For visiting boats, contact Port Captain, Mike Barker 808-247-4121 at least one week prior to arrival at KYC to discuss mooring arrangements. To facilitate mooring arrangements boats must provide LOA, beam, and draft data on their entry form and to the KYC Port Captain.
