Organizing Authority: The organizing authority is the Baltimore County Sailing Center.

Classes: Club 420, ILCA 6/Laser Radial and Optimist (championship fleet-white, blue, red). Optimist Green Fleet clinic. 420 and ILCA 6/Laser Radial competitors shall not reach their 21st birthday in 2024 and shall not have participated in any ICSA-sanctioned regatta previously. Optimist sailors shall not reach their 16th birthday in 2024. Sailors may not be compensated financially for sailing in the regatta as skipper or crew. Pinnies are recommended but not required.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021-2024, the prescriptions of US Sailing and the class rules of participating boats (except as any are changed by the Sailing Instructions).

Registration: On-line registration through Regatta Network is required. Registration closes at 0900 EDT on day one of the regatta. \$80 per singlehanded boat (ILCA 6, Optimist) and \$160 per doublehanded boat (420) includes racing, souvenir, Thursday night barbecue dinner, awards ceremony and post-race snacks. After 0200 hours on Saturday, July 13, 2024, an additional \$15 late fee per singlehanded sailor (\$25 for doublehanded boat) will be added. No refunds except for duplicate registrations. No lunch is provided. Please bring a refillable water bottle. There will be water dispensers on hand to refill.

Green Fleet Clinic Registration: On-line registration through Regatta Network. \$80 per sailor includes coaching, CBYRA souvenir, Thursday night barbecue dinner and post-race snacks. There is no late fee for CBYRA Clinic to encourage participation amongst Green Fleet sailors.

Awards: Trophies for 1st-3rd in 420, ILCA 6/Radial and Op mist Red, Blue and White fleets and Overall winner in Optimist fleet (Maryland State Champion).
