2024 HKBC Keelboat Race June 29, 2024

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Hawaii Kai Boat Club (HKBC) is the organizing authority.

1. RULES:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS),* the prescriptions of US SAILING.
- **2. ADVERTISING:** Advertising will not be restricted.
- **3. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS** will be posted on Regatta Network.

4. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

4.1 Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted at least three hours prior to the start.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES:

Warning 1055 on Saturday June 29, 2024,

6. RACING AREAS: The racing areas are the coastal waters of South Shore Oahu.

7. THE STARTS:

There will be one start for all boats. All boats shall start at 1100. Each boat shall start according to GPS time. There will be no race committee on station and no flags or bells.

8. The Finish:

All boats shall take their own time and text the finish time to 808 255-6325 with boat name and finish time.

9. THE START/FINISH LINES & COURSE:

Start Area - Ala Wai Yacht Harbor Turning Basin

Start Line - Start Line is between the Hawaii Yacht Club flag pole and a white strip painted on the rock on the Magic Island side of the channel.

Finish Line – The Finish Line is the same as the Start Line.

The Course: Start, Ala Wai channel R2 (P), DH (P), Kalihi Entrance Channel G1 (S), Ala Wai G1 (P), Finish. distance approximately 12.15 NM:

No other navigation aids have any significance.

10. PROTESTS:

A yacht intending to protest shall notify the HKBC Race Commodore by hail or on VHF channel 68 promptly after finishing that race.

Protests shall be filed along with a case of beer to HKBC Commodore Billy Balding in writing within one hour from the time that the last boat finishes.

Protests will be heard whenever it is convenient.

11. SAFETY REGULATIONS:
