NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

You are cordially invited to join us for the Coconut Grove Sailing Club's 2024 Annual Cruising Regatta. One design boats are welcome to race in the ARC class, with the class-assigned handicap.

Registration. The registration fee is \$0 for BBYRA PHRF boats and \$40 for all other boats. All boats (including BBYRA) must register at <u>regattanetwork.com/event/28840</u> on or before 6pm on Thursday,October 3, 2024. No registrations will be accepted after that date and time. Registering skippers must indicate the names and emails of all crew, and each crew person must complete a short crew registration, agreeing to the regatta waiver of liability.

Sailing Instructions. Racing will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, except as modified and supplemented by the Biscayne Bay Yacht Racing Association Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions 2023-2024, General Conditions and Sailing Instructions, Part II – Sailing Instructions: Handicap (available at www.bbyra.net). No separate Sailing Instructions will be issued.

Protests. Protests and requests for redress should be initiated by filling out the online Protest form here. Additionally, if a diagram is required, it should be photographed and emailed to Protest@cgsc.org. Alternatively, a completed Protest form may be photographed and emailed to Protest@cgsc.org. A protest email is sufficient (instead of the actual protest form) if it includes the name or sail numbers of the boat protesting and being protested, the incident, where and when the incident occurred, and (if possible) a cell phone number suitable for texting. Protests shall be delivered within 1 hour after the Race Committee Signal Boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the official notice board on Regatta https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/28440# newsroom. Hearings will be held as soon as practicable after racing via Zoom. This changes BBYRA 15.2.

GENERAL INFORMATION APPLICABLE TO ALL CLASSES

- On race day, each yacht must check-in by sailing past the stern of the Race Committee boat on starboard tack prior to the warning signal of the first race in which it will be competing. No check-ins will be accepted during a starting sequence.
- Class Flags for the Handicap Classes will be as follows:

PHRF Spinnaker - Dark Blue & White
PHRF Non-Spinnaker - Orange & White
ARC Class - Dark Green

 <u>CGSC parking is limited to Members only</u>. Parking is available around the circle (metered) or at the Public Parking lots around the Grove.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place boats in all classes with at least five boats starting. The ARC class may be divided into subcategories at the discretion of the Organizing Authority for the purpose of prize giving. A 1st place will be awarded to classes with less than five yachts starting.
