NOTICE OF RACE

Posted December 26 2024, Amended January 26 2005

RULES:

- The Organizing Authority is Coconut Grove Sailing Club and Miami Snipe Fleet #7.
- The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ("RRS") and by the SCIRA 2025 Non-Championship Rules of Conduct ("ROC").
- The following Prescriptions of US Sailing are the only Prescriptions that will apply: Appendix R, the prescription to the preamble to Part 5, and the prescriptions to rules 65.1, 70.3(b), 76.1 and 88.2.
- Each Snipe racing in this event must have aboard life-saving equipment conforming to government regulations in either the USA or the home country of each of the sailors aboard.
- The following Rules may be amended in the Sailing Instructions: RRS 27.1, 30.4, 32, 33, 35, 44.3(c), 61, and 62.2; RRS Appendices A2, A4, A5, and A11; and RRS Race Signals.
- There may be judges afloat calling modified Appendix P. More details will be included in the sailing instructions.

ADVERTISING: Advertising is permitted as per Snipe Class Rules. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

The event is open to SCIRA registered boats and Class Member skippers who are in good standing with SCIRA for the current year. As only skippers are required to be SCIRA members, this changes ROC 3. However, If a Junior or Women skipper intends to qualify for the 2025 Western Hemisphere and Asia Championship, both skipper and crew must be members. Full payment must be received for registration to be complete.

FEES: \$185.00 if payment received by 6pm on Friday, March 21, 2025.

\$215.00 if payment received after 6pm on March 21, 2025

No entries will be accepted after 1800 hours on April 2, 2025.

SCHEDULE: No more than four (4) races are scheduled per day, with a maximum of

eight (8) races for the event. This modifies ROC 4.1.

Vehicle parking on Club property available only for Club members. Trailers

must be stored off property.

COURSES: As per the Sailing Instructions.

SCORING: Low Point System in RRS Appendix "A" of shall be used, except that no

races shall be excluded.

A "DNF" will receive points equal to the number of finishers plus 2.

A 10% penalty applies to the first race of the day if a boat fails to check in or if bow numbers supplied by the Organizing Authority are not properly affixed.

AWARDS: Skipper and crew for first through fifth places, top Under 30 skipper and crew

and top Women skipper and crew. Also, the District 4 Guy Roberts - Francis Seavy Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the top placing skipper/crew who

are both District 4 SCIRA members.

QUALIFICATION FOR SUBSEQUENT EVENT:

Woman and junior (born after 12/31/03) skippers can qualify for the Western Hemisphere and Asia Championship in San Diego CA on September 2-6, 2025. To qualify, Don Q crew must be SCIRA members, but need not be women or juniors.

The following criteria will be used:

- 1. The Top Woman skipper in the final regatta ranking will earn the Woman qualification spot.
- 2. The Top Junior in the final regatta ranking will earn the Junior qualification spot, unless she has earned the Woman Qualification spot, in which case the #2 Junior will earn the qualification spot.

- 3. If a qualified skipper declines to attend or has already earned a qualification spot by other means, then the qualification spot goes to the next Woman or Junior in the final regatta ranking
- 4. If there are no qualified skippers, either because none participated or none accepted, then the qualification spot(s) will go unfilled.
