Notice of Race

80th Annual Lahaina to Honolulu Race

Monday, September 2, 2024

Organizing Authority: Hawaii Yacht Club (HYC)

1. **RULES**

- 1.1. The race will be conducted according to *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024*, including US Sailing Prescriptions, Hawaii Yacht Racing Association [HYRA] Prescriptions and HYC Standing Sailing Instructions for Offshore Races unless otherwise amended in this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing Rules of Sailing [RRS] 51 and 52 are modified to allow the use of integrally designed Canting Ballast Twin Foil [CBTF] and water ballast technology.
- 1.3. RRS 52 is modified to allow the use of winches operated using stored power.

2. **ADVERTISING** shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20. Competitor advertising will not be restricted.

3. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all yachts that meet requirements for ISAF Offshore Special Regulations Category 3 (no liferaft required) and are members of HYRA member clubs, and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authority.
- 3.2. Liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$500,000 is required.
- 3.3. Eligible yachts may enter via the US Sailing RegattaNetwork website between August 4 and August 31, 2024 - 1800 hrs. Entries will only be accepted using the RegattaNetwork website. <http://www.regattanetwork.com/html/calendar.html>

4. **MOORING**

- 4.1. Mooring/anchorage in Ka'anapali is available on a first-come, first serve basis. The Lahaina Small Boat Harbor is absolutely off limits and no shore services are available. The Harbor Agents can be reached at 808-662-4060.

4.3. Mooring in Waikiki after the regatta is available on a first come first serve basis. Temporary moorings may be available at the Ala Wai Harbor or at the H Dock. The Ala Wai Harbor Master can be reached at 808-973-9727. HYC Port Captain, Malachi 757-359-9247

7. **MEASUREMENTS & HANDICAPS** Each boat shall have a valid Performance Handicap Racing Fleet [NCPHRF] handicap certificate issued by YRA or be assigned a temporary handicap.

8. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing instructions will be available at the skippers' meeting, via Regatta Network.

9. **VENUE/COURSE**

The course will be a race from Ka'anapali, Maui to Ala Wai Boat Harbor, Oahu.

10. **SCORING**

10.1. Corrected times will be calculated using the PHRF Time-on-Time scoring system, as adopted by HYRA.

10.2. The low point system of RRS Appendix A shall apply without modification.

11. PRIZES

For each class, first prize will be awarded if at least three boats enter, second prize will be awarded if at least five boats enter, and third prize will be awarded if at least seven boats enter.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$500,000 per event or the equivalent.
