NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES :

1.1. The Commodore John V. Dugan, III Round the Cat Race is organized under the authority of the Pass Christian Yacht Club and will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.2. All entrants must have working running lights, life-lines, a VHF radio, and cell phone onboard. Cell phone numbers must be included on the registration form.

1.3. Other rules may be changed and these changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2. CLASSES & ELIGIBILITY:

2.1 Classes to be sailed: PHRF Spinnaker

2.2 All entrants must complete the registration form online at the Regatta Page

2.3 All yachts must have a current ORRez PHRF Spinnaker or Non-Spinnaker Rating.

3. ENTRIES & FEES:

3.1 All entries must be received by 0945 hours September 28th, 2024.

3.2 All entries must check-in with their completed Crew Lists at the registration desk at Pass Christian Yacht Club by 0945 hours September 28th, 2024. Fees: \$50

4. SAFETY:

4.1 All boats shall comply with United States Coast Guard safety equipment regulations.

4.2 Boats competing in the GORC (PHRF Classes) shall comply with the US Sailing Special Equipment Requirements for Nearshore Racing, check-In with Race Committee at the beginning of each day of racing with all of the crew wearing their PFD's, carry a working motor with enough fuel to motor 20 miles, and have proper working navigation lights.

4.3 A boat shall report for any safety inspection when asked to do so by the Race Committee or Protest Committee. Any boat found without all safety items may incur a scoring penalty or be disqualified by the Protest Committee.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be available at the Registration Desk during Check- In.
