

1. Rules

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the

Racing Rules of Sailing.



- 1.2 Competitors shall wear US Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices whilst afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wetsuits and drysuits are not personal flotation devices.
- 1.3 A VHF Radio is required for all participating boats. (Channel 72)

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to any double hauled sail boats that can be launched and recovered from the beach.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter at Regatta Network: Multi hull Test and Tune HHI : South Carolina Yacht Club (regattanetwork.com) and signing the participation waiver for this event.

5. Schedule

- 5.2 Dates of racing: October 26 Saturday Medium Distance Race (Approximately 10 Nautical Miles) October 27 Buoy Racing (5)
- 5.3 The Scheduled time of the warning signal Saturday will be 11:00am



The Scheduled time of the warning signal for Sunday will be 10:00 am No start sequence will begin after 3:30 pm. Race director may change race format depending upon conditions.

6. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available after October 24th online or a paper copy will be available at registration.

7. Venue

7.1 Atlantic Ocean, just off the beach in front of the Beach House Hotel, Hilton Head Island.

8. The Courses

The courses will be medium distance race. Wind direction will be dependent of mark location.

Course 1—Starting line off beach, heading North to Port Royal entry channel mark G19, Round to Port, return to the finish line off the beach Course 2 – Staring line off the beach, heading South to Hilton Head Island Entry Channel mark R6, round to port, finish at the finish line off the beach.

Course 3 – Start line to a windward mark, round to port, reach mark to part, leeward mark to port, and finish

9. Penalty System

9.1 Rule 44.1 has changed so that a Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty

10. Scoring

- 10.1 The scoring system will be low point scoring for the series.
- 10.2 1 Race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.3 Boats will be scored using US Sailing Portsmith DPN Rating System.

11. Berthing

Boats shall be kept on the Beach House Hotel beach front in the designated areas only.

12. Radio Communication

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive any communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. Race Committee can be hailed on channel 72

13. Prizes

Prices will be given to the top Three boats in each class.

14. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in the conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

15. Safety

- 15.1 Sailors are strongly recommended to use trapeze harnesses with a quick release hookless system or a quick release hook, which meets the ISO 10862 standard.
- 15.2 All competitors must have a working VHF radio and monitor channel 72 while afloat.
- 15.3 All competitors must wear a USCG approved PFD while afloat during racing.
- 15.4 Sailors are encouraged to have a cell phone in water proof case, sail knife, and adequate hydration for races.
