# **Notice Of Race**

#### 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2024, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the by-laws and appendices of the Comet Class Yacht Racing Association (CCYRA) and the Sailing Instructions. CCYRA rules also require paddle and PFD's onboard all boats.

### **2. ADVERTISING**

Advertising will be restricted to Category A as stated in ISAF Regulation 20.

### **3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

This event is open to CCYRA members who have <u>paid</u> their 2023 dues. Membership information can be found at <u>http://www.cometclass.com/membership.htm</u>.

Eligible yachts must register for the regatta at RegattaNetwork.com by October 9th. See link at www.cryc.org

All participants must complete the liability waiver, and submit at the registration desk.

#### 4. REGISTRATION

The <u>CCYRA 2024 Comet International Championship Regatta</u> entry fee is \$300 per boat. Registration will be Thursday evening 5:00 to 8:00 and Friday 8:00 to 9:00 AM. The registration fee provides for 3 days of racing (weather permitting), Thursday evening welcoming cookout; Friday continental breakfast, lunch, crabcake dinner; Saturday, a continental breakfast, lunch, Eastern Shore dinner; Sunday, continental breakfast, cookout after racing with awards. All beverages are included.

#### **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### 7. VENUE

Corsica River Yacht Club (<u>CRYC.org</u>), 589 Conquest Rd Centreville, Maryland 21617

#### Launching and overnight boat storage

One boat lift is available for launching and haul out. Limited dock storage available.

#### 8. THE COURSE

The sailing course for the International Championship will be Windward/Leeward or Olympic course as described in the Sailing Instructions. The course may be shortened at the discretion of the race committee. Races will be on the Chester or Corsica Rivers.

#### 9. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply. A total of six races are planned. One race is required to constitute a series. If five or more races are completed, worst score will be dropped. This modifies RRS A2.

#### **10. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**

A boat may carry a radio for emergency communications and announcements from the race committee.

#### **11. REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT**

All competitors shall carry a U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) approved personal floatation device (PFD). Competitors from outside the U.S. shall carry a PFD approved by their nations' certification authority to the extent permitted by international treaty. *CCYRA Specified:* All boats shall carry a paddle, and a 50 ft tow line per CCYRA specifications, Section 16. Additionally, a centerboard hold down line will be required by the organizing authority.

#### **12. PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES**

12.1 No competitor shall use, either on or off the water: marijuana or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 U.S. Code 802) the possession of which is unlawful under 21 U.S. Code 841. No competitor, member of the race committee, or member of the safety patrol shall use alcohol during racing. The consumption of alcohol by competitors under age 21 is strictly prohibited during the entire event.

12.2 An alleged breach of one of these regulations shall not be grounds for a protest. However, when the protest committee believes that a competitor may have breached one of these regulations, it shall follow the process described in racing rule 69.1 and a competitor found to have breached one of these regulations shall be excluded from the remaining races in the series, and where practical removed from the regatta venue and sent home. The competitor's boat shall be disqualified from all races of the series.
