

Melges 15 Fall Regatta SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2024 NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: Sarasota Sailing Squadron (SSS) 1717 Ken Thompson Parkway, Sarasota, FL 34236

1. Rules:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The rules of the Melges 15 Class Association will apply.
- 1.3 RRS 63.7 is replaced with "If there is a conflict between a rule in the notice of race and one in the sailing instructions, the sailing instructions shall apply."

2. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be available no later than 1800 on Friday, November 2, 2024 online at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/28700

3. Communication

- 3.1 The official notice board will be located at the Sarasota Sailing Squadron (SSS), under the main pavilion.
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channels used will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.3 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that are not available to all boats.

4. Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the Melges 15 class.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and submitting the required entry fee online at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/28700 prior to close of registration

5. **Fees**

- 5.1 The entry fee for all boats is \$30 which includes post-racing food and beverage for skipper and crew on Sunday. Registration fee will increase an additional \$25 after October 25, 2024.
- 5.2 Additionally, there is a \$30 fee for non-member use of facilities and storage of Melges 15 on dollies at the SSS for those sailing the Sarasota Yacht Club (SYC) Regatta on Saturday, November 2, 2024.

6. Advertising

Shall be in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20, advertising code.

8. Number of Races

Up to 4 races on a windward/leeward course are scheduled.

10. Scoring

A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. One race is required to constitute a series. For the overall weekend, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores from the SYC and SSS Regattas and no races shall be excluded.

11. Image Release

By participating in this regatta, a competitor grants to the organizing authority, Sarasota Sailing Squadron, and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped, or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

12. Risk Statement

Competitors compete in the regatta at their own risk. See RRS 3 (Decision to Race) and RRS 4 (Acceptance of Rules). The host club, organizing authority, sponsors, their associates and appointees and volunteers will not accept any liability for damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

13. Prizes

For the SSS Melges 15 Regatta, awards will be presented for first to third place. Depending on registrations as of October 25, 2024, additional prizes may be awarded, such as for top youth (under 18 as of the date of the regatta), top female skipper and top "meister" (over the age of 65 as of the date of the regatta), who do not finish in the top three. Additional awards based on the overall weekend scores may be awarded.

14. Parking

The Sarasota Sailing Squadron is a very active sailing club. Parking is available outside of the main entrance. Parking inside the main entrance on Squadron grounds is limited to Squadron members. Cars parked on the Squadron grounds that do not display a member's decal and any car / trailer that block a member's boat / trailer may be towed at the owner's expense.
