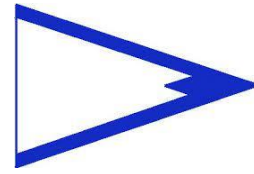
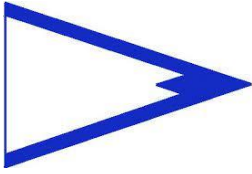
- a) There will be multiple races per day.

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

### 6. VENUE

Manasquan River between the Route 35 Bridge and the canal.



**7. THE COURSES**

Windward/Leeward (WL) /Triangular/ (T or TWL).

**8. SCORING**

- a) The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A.
- b) 1 race must be completed to constitute the series.
- c) The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply as changed below. RRS A2 is changed so one (1) race will be excluded for every four (4) races completed.
- d) No race shall be declared official unless three or more entrants come to the starting line.

**9. BERTHING**

Boat Storage is available free of charge, to those registered for the series. Skippers intending to store their boat at MRYC during the series should notify MRYC’s General Manager in advance of arriving Please call 732 528-6792.

**10. REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT**

**Notes:**

- 1. Manual bailer must be a minimum of 4-quart capacity.
- 2. All boats must carry a towline solely dedicated to towing and/or anchoring and readily available for use at all times. Line must be at least 24’ long and of sufficient strength to tow a swamped boat.

**11. AWARDS**

Awards will be presented at the annual MRYC Sailing Awards presentation.

**12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor’s participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

**13. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of the policy limit of their homeowner’s insurance policy per event or the equivalent thereof.
