NOTICE OF RACE

This Boat-of-the-Year event for DIYC encourages participation from veteran racers to casual cruisers looking to check out the racing scene. There are divisions for everyone with choices in Spinnaker, Racer-Cruiser, and Cruising. This one-day event features Hillsborough Bay Drop-Mark races for Spinnaker Divisions and a Distance course for the other Divisions. After an afternoon of racing, DIYC hosts our traditional adult Halloween party. Costumes are strongly encouraged for the awards party – for a separate competition of course. The race is only half the fun.

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* including Appendix T (Arbitration), and the DIYC 2024-2025 Boat of the Year Notice of Series.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats with a valid WFPHRF Certificate, or a temporary rating assigned by the DIYC Club Measurer. Melges 24s are not required to have a WFPHRF Certificate.
- 2.2 Expected Divisions are Spinnaker (A/B/C), Racer-Cruiser, Cruising, Melges-24, and Multihull.
- 2.3 Under West Florida PHRF rules, this is a Category 4 event for the Distance Course and Category 5 for Spinnaker Divisions.
- 2.4 Cruising spinnakers are permitted for the Cruising Division. All Cruising boats intending to use a cruising spinnaker must declare so by email to SailingSecretary@divc.org at least two days prior to the event.
- 2.5 Boats may enter on-line at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/28717 or by following the link from the DIYC Home page. Entries close at 1800 on October 25.

3 FEES

All boats: \$107.50 (\$100.00 plus 7.5% tax)

Regatta Fee includes: soda and keg of beer at post race party, 2 dinner tickets per boat, Live Music and

Awards.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the Regatta Network event website.

6 VENUE AND COURSES

- 6.1 Racer-Cruiser, Cruising, and Multihull will race a distance race in Tampa Bay using fixed marks. The race is scheduled for up to 25 miles.
- 6.2 Spinnaker Divisions will race on Drop-mark courses in Hillsborough Bay, as many races as possible depending on time and weather conditions.

7 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 7.1 All Divisions will use the Scoring Penalty of RRS 44.3.
- 7.2 Arbitration will be offered including a voluntary 30% scoring penalty.

8 SCORING

All handicap racing will be scored TOD using West Florida PHRF ratings:

Spinnaker Divisions

Melges-24

All Distance Course Divisions

Buoy Rating
One-Design
RLC Rating

9 PRIZES and Awards party including costume judging

Following a day of racing, the Awards Party will include soda and a free keg of beer as well as live music. There will also be a buffet dinner for purchase but two dinner tickets are included in the Regatta Fee. All crews are encouraged to <u>dress in costume</u> for the party. The theme for this year's costume competition is a Netflix Series. This is an adult costume and awards party.

Prizes will be awarded in each Division for first place, if 1-3 boats; top two, if 4-5 boats; top three, if 6 or more boats.

Awards will go to the best 3 boat's costumes.
