

## 2024 TWO HARBOR FALL SERIES NOTICE OF RACE



Anacapa Yacht Club and Pierpont Bay Yacht Club invite you to enter the 2024 Two Harbor Fall Series. This series offers the best of fall racing in a three-race series with no throw-outs. Please note that AnYC will host races 1 and 3 and PBYC will host race 2. The finish will be at the Mandalay buoy. Racers will take and report their finish times to the RC. We look forward to seeing you on the water.

**DATES:** Race #1: October 5 (hosted by AnYC)

Race #2: October 26 (hosted by PBYC)
Race #3: November 9 (hosted by AnYC)

**TIME:** The start signal for the first class is scheduled for 1130 hours each race day.

**COURSES:** The courses will be chosen from the 2024 Two Harbor Fall Series Course Chart. Course lengths vary from 7 to 23 nautical miles and are coastal in nature. All starts and finishes will be in the vicinity of the Mandalay buoy.

**CLASSES:** PHRF-handicapped spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes, and an ORCA-handicapped class will be formed with class breaks determined by entries. In addition, lifeline requirements 2.4.1 – 2.4.8 apply with the exception that coated lifelines are permitted. These changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. PHRF area A Random Leg Course handicaps will be used.

ENTRY: The races will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*. Entries for the Series or race close at 1700 on the Friday preceding each race. The Sailing Instructions will be available through Regatta Network. The entry fee for the series is \$85 (\$75 for USSA members), and the entry fee for individual races is \$32 (\$28 for USSA members).

**TROPHIES:** To be eligible to win series trophies, PHRF boats must have valid PHRF ratings. Boats without valid PHRF ratings will be assigned a temporary rating for this race only by the race management team. Series trophies will be awarded after the last race at AnYC.



MONTH.
