Notice of Regatta

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

The notation '[DP]' in a rule means that the penalty for a breach of the rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. Rules

- 1.1 Races will be governed by 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Regatta Sailing Instructions. Buccaneer Yacht Club will administer the race. Sailing Instructions will be available on-line at http://bucyc.com or on regattanetwork.com.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of US Sailing will not apply except the prescriptions to Rules 61.4, 67 and 76.1.
- 1.3 Under Rule 86, Changes to the Racing Rules, the following rules are changed as follows:
- 1.3.1 Rules A4 and A5 are changed to state that a boat starting later than four (4) minutes after her starting signal will be given a 20% scoring penalty without a hearing, calculated as stated in Rule 44.3(c). This changes RRS 63.1.
- 1.3.2 [NP] Boats may be finished on the course (FOC) at the discretion of the race committee. The RC determines the method and order of finishing. This changes RRS 35, A5.1 and A5.2.
- 1.4 RRS 40.1, Personal Flotation Devices, Basic Rule, always applies while racing.

2. Expected Classes

- 2.1 Multihull
- 2.2 There is a 4 boat minimum for a one design class.
