



# Turkey Trot Regatta

## Saturday, November 16, 2024

### Notice of Race – *including Amendment 1*

Blackbeard Sailing Club (BSC), New Bern, NC is the Organizing Authority (OA) and venue host for the regatta.

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the various class rules, and the rules and regulations of the NC Wildlife Commission and the US Coast Guard.
- 1.2 Section V1 of RRS Appendix V Alternative Penalties applies.
- 1.3 Sections T2, T3 and T4 of RRS Appendix T Arbitration apply. This changes Appendix T.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between the RRS and class rules, the class rules apply.

#### **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The event is open to San Juan 21 Working Sails, San Juan 21 All Sails, Sunfish, Ensigns, and Wetas. Other one-designs may be accepted at the discretion of the OA.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and paying online at [www.regattanetwork.com/event/28827](http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/28827) by 2000 on Monday, November 11, 2024 (early entry deadline.) Late entries may be accepted until 0800 on Friday, November 15, 2024 for an additional fee, and only in already established classes.
- 2.3 A minimum of 4 boats must register by the early entry deadline or the event will be cancelled. A minimum of 3 entrants in each class are required by the early entry deadline to establish a class. There will be no “Open” class.

#### **3 FEES**

The entry fee for all classes is \$20.00 which may be paid online when registering at Regatta Network. A late fee of \$10.00 will be added to entries submitted after 2000 on Monday, November 11, 2024. The fee includes the after racing social.

#### **4 VENUE**

- 4.1 Race headquarters and social events will be at BSC.
- 4.2 Racing will be on Upper Broad Creek in the vicinity of BSC or on the Neuse River, as the PRO indicates at the competitors’ meeting.

## **5 SCHEDULE**

**0930-0955** Check in at BSC. Payment of entry fee by check only will be accepted.

**1000** Competitors' meeting on the deck at BSC.

**1125** First signal for first class. More races to follow as conditions permit.

No races will be started after **1500**

**1700** Potluck social and awards after racing at BSC. Entrée will be provided.

**Please bring a side dish or dessert to share.**

## **6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be posted no later than 0800 Friday, November 15 online at [www.regattanetwork.com/event/28827](http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/28827) and on the courtesy notice board located on the windows facing the deck at BSC by 0945 on Saturday, November 16.

## **7 COURSE(S)**

The course(s) to be sailed are defined in Attachment A.

## **8 SCORING**

8.1 Low point scoring as described in Appendix A of the RRS applies.

8.2 One completed race is required to constitute the Regatta.

8.3 If 5 or fewer races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2. If 6 or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **9 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded to the top 2 boats in each class during the social after racing.

## **10 INSURANCE, SAFETY & DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

10.1 Each participating boat must be insured with an adequate valid third-party liability policy.

10.2 RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone." By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform, and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.
