



## NOTICE OF RACE

### Lady at the Helm Race

Saturday, November 2, 2024

Organizing Authorities:

Channel Islands Yacht Club (CIYC) and  
Channel Islands Women's Sailing Association (CIWSA)



- RULES:** The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. At least one female crew must be aboard, and a **female must be at the helm during the entire race - particularly during the start, finish, and all mark roundings**. Male crew may coach the helmswoman but must remain completely “hands-off” the helm except for periodic short breaks (<5min) or a true emergency.
- RACE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & FEES:** Spinnaker, nonspinnaker, and/or cruising classes are offered. PHRF Area A Random Leg Course (RLC) ratings will be used for scoring. The Race Committee (RC) may assign a temporary rating for any seaworthy boat without a current PHRF certificate, and rating adjustments for cruising sailboats will be offered.

Race entry, payment of entry fees (\$35), and race documents will be available online at Regatta Network (<https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/28841>). Entry fees will be discounted by \$5 for members of CIYC, CIWSA, and/or USSA.

- SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The race will start and finish in the vicinity of the Mandalay Race Buoy. Course options range between 4.2 and 19.5nm. Prior to the Skippers Meeting, the Sailing Instructions (SIs) and Course Chart will be posted online (<https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/28841>).
- PRIZES:** Individual prizes will be awarded after racing. Current PHRF registration is required to be eligible for the perpetual Lady at the Helm trophy, which will be engraved with the name(s) of the winning boat(s) and skipper(s) and displayed at CIYC.
- HOSPITALITY:** After racing, CIYC (4100 Harbor Blvd, Oxnard, CA 93035) will host an awards presentation with hot food and a no-host bar beginning at approximately 1630.
- RISK STATEMENT:** *RRS 3* states: ‘The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.’ By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform, and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- INSURANCE AND SAFETY EQUIPMENT:** All boats shall carry third-party liability insurance and a VHF radio with Channels 16 and 68. Compliance with near-coastal safety equipment requirements (<https://ussailing2018.wpenginepowered.com/wp-content/uploads/2022/01/Monohull-SER-2022.0-Nearshore.pdf>) is strongly recommended.
