The folks at CDIP know and share the latest position of each buoy. You then, can see the position of the buoy relative to its anchor and its path within the past **6 hours**. The lat/long of its floating position is provided as well! Unofficially, this might be your waypoint to the mark. 😊

- A: On the world map zoom in to the Pt Loma South buoy
 - Click on the green dot
 - Click on the highlighted Lat/Long
 - Click on the buoy to see the Lat/Long of its most recent position
 - Have fun with “Map Options” to see the track of the buoy and the “Polyline Measurement” tool to see distances.

OR

- B: Type 191 in the “Search” box below the world map
 - Click on the buoy’s name in the table
 - In the “Station Details” window, click on either highlighted Lat or Long
 - Click on the buoy to see the Lat/Long of its most recent position
 - Have fun with “Map Options” to see the track of the buoy and the “Polyline Measurement” tool to see distances.
