# **Amendement #2 to Sailing Instructions**

9.2 and 9.3 is Corrected to Read

#### 9. The Start and Finish

- 9.2 The Start will be between an Orange Flag on the RC boat and a Yellow Starting Pin Cylinder
- 9.3 The Finish will be between a Blue Flag on the RC boat and a Yellow Finish Pin Cylinder

### 10.1 is Corrected to Read

#### 10. Pin Boat

10.1 A mark boat may be near the pin end of the start/finish line and is authorized to identify premature starters and to record finishers. may be a reference/source of information to the person calling the line. Mark boats are to be considered "obstructions," even when not anchored.

### 14.2 is Corrected to Read

#### 14. Protests

14.2 Protests must be written on forms available at the CCSC Main Office and lodged with Main Office personnel no later than 30 minutes after the RC Arrival on shore 75 minutes after the last boat finishes

# The following is added to SI 16

## 16. Safety

- 16.3 After Sailing each day, coaches must check in with the Main Office and verify that their sailors made it to shore. Failure to comply will incur a 1 point penalty to each related competitor, added to the last race of the day the infraction occurred.
- 16.4 Each Day, upon arrival to the course area each boat must check in with the race committee by sailing astern of the RC boat on starboard and hail their sail number
