1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, including Appendix V.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to class members / boats of the Fireball, Interlake, Albacore, 505 and other Friends. (Melges15, Thistle, Windmill, Portsmouth fleets, etc.). Any one-design class with five (5) or more entries by March 3 will get their own start.

3 FEES

3-person boat – (\$225+\$14.63 tax) \$239.63

2-person boat – (\$185+\$12.03 tax) \$197.03

1-person boat – (\$125+\$8.13 tax) \$133.13

A \$50 late fee will be applied after February 28th.

Extra social tickets may be purchased for \$ TBD per person.

The entry fee will include continental breakfast Saturday, Sunday, and Saturday dinner, etc., launching and hauling, facilities, trailer parking and camping.

Additional regatta merchandise, breakfast, dinner tickets, and boxed lunches will be available for purchase for each day, by reservation and payment at registration.

7 SCORING

7.1 Fifteen (15) races are scheduled. A minimum of one completed race is required to constitute a series.

7.2 Drop races will be defined by each individual class in the Sailing Instructions.

8 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded in each class based on the number of entrants.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

9.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race.

9.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, illness, disease, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

9.3 Competitors will be required to sign a waiver of liability during registration.

10 WATER SAFETY

All outboard-equipped support vessels shall be equipped with a functioning engine safety cut-out switch (kill switch) which shall remain attached to the support person (operator) at all times when the engine is running. Support vessels shall check-in with the RC Signal vessel before the first race of each day to demonstrate compliance. Failure to comply may be considered misconduct.

11 INTERLAKE

Regarding #14e of article III of the ISCA specifications, the Race Committee intends to use and allow VHF radios on the race course to communicate with the competitors.
