

We want our sailing programs to be a safe and welcoming environment for all kids. Therefore, we have guidelines and policies in place to ensure that camps and practices will be a positive space. We want to avoid unacceptable behavior. Unacceptable behavior includes:

1. Physical aggression of any kind (includes hitting, fighting, and inappropriate physical touch)
2. Teasing, making fun of someone, name-calling, or any other acts of bullying
3. Use of substances (includes tobacco, vapes, alcohol, and illicit drugs). If your child needs to take medication while on the premises, please let me or a coach know in advance.
4. Endangering the health and safety of campers and/or staff
5. Refusing to follow behavior guidelines or camp rules
6. Using profanity, vulgarity, or obscenity
7. Stealing or damaging property (personal or camp property)
8. Refusal to participate in activities or cooperate with staff
9. Disrupting an activity or leaving an activity without permission

Engaging in any of the unacceptable behaviors may be disciplined with a temporary “time out” away from the group. In a severe case, parents may be called to pick up the camper. Physical aggression may result in expulsion from the program without refund. Additionally, we ask that campers avoid conversations in religion and politics. It is really important to us that every camper gets to enjoy the program safely. Thank you for your cooperation!
