

2025 ANNUAL REGATTA AND COWTOWN STAMPEDE

Notice of Race

HE FORT WORTH BOAT CLUB AS THE ORGANIZING AUTHORITY (OA) CORDIALLY INVITES YOU TO THE 2025 ANNUAL REGATTA AND COWTOWN STAMPEDE ON BEAUTIFUL EAGLE MOUNTAIN LAKE.

1. Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)2025 - 2028, and the class rules of the applicable one-design classes.

1.2 By entering, all competitors agree to abide by and support the US Sailing Statement of Ethics and Code of Conduct. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and the class rules of the applicable one-design classes, with the exception of the crew weights for J105 (J105 crews will be limited to a total seven (7) with no weight limit.) J22 FWBC fleet crews will be limited to a total of three (3) with no weight limit.

2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats with either a valid PHRF rating or a Portsmouth Yardstick rating. Any one design boat intending to race only in a one design fleet does not have to have a PHRF or Portsmouth Yardstick rating to enter.

2.2 All eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form on Regatta Network at the following url and paying the required registration fee via https://www.fortworthboatclub.com/regattas

2.3 One design classes may be declared for fleets with three (3) or more entries for fleets such as J105, J70 J24, J22, RS Aero, FJ, Laser, etc..

3. Fee

3.1 The registration fee for this regatta is payable at the time of registration.

6. Venue and Courses

6.1 Fort Worth Boat Club and the racing area are located on Eagle Mountain Lake.

6.2 The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward, triangle, olympic style or point to point distance racing using permanent or temporary racing marks.

6.3 Offset weather marks and leeward gates may be used.

6.4 Course diagrams will be available in the SIs.

7. Scoring

7.1 One (1) race is required to constitute a regatta.

7.2 Six (6) races are scheduled.

7.3 The scoring system is the Low Point System. Each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. If six (6) races are completed, there will be one (1) discard.

7.4 Results will be posted on <u>www.fortwortboatclub.com/regattas</u> and on the official notice board at Fort Worth Boat Club at the patio entrance to the Regatta Bar.

8. Prizes

8.1 Trophies will be awarded according to the number of boats registered by class at the time early discount closes on Sunday March 23, 2025 as follows:

1 - 3 Boats - First

4 - 5 Boats - First and Second

6 - 9 Boats - First, Second and Third

10 + Boats - First, Second, Third and Fourth

9. Catering

9.1 A complimentary breakfast will be available for race crews and race committee members on Saturday and Sunday prior to racing.

9.2 Packed lunches will be available for pre-order when registering for \$12.00 each for Saturday 20th April. Please order before Friday 4th April.

9.3 Dinner will be available on Saturday 5th April, Reservations can be placed whilst registering or at check in.

10. Radio Communications

10.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

10.2 VHF Communications. The Race Committee intends to broadcast courtesy information to competitors via VHF. These may be more fully described in the Sailing Instructions along with applicable channels.

10.3 Boats are encouraged to carry VHF radios capable of transmitting and receiving on US channels 9, 16, 69, 71,72, 73, and 78.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The OA will not accept liability for material damage or bodily injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

11.2 Entrance into the regatta by a participant or their crew constitutes acceptance of this section.

12. Insurance

12.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of (US) \$500,000.00 per incident

13. FWBC J22's

13.1 The Fort Worth Boat Club J22 fleet boats are available for charter. Charter costs are outlined on the event website when registering for the event. The charter document is available on the event website or from the FWBC office.

14. Further Information
