## The 2025 Jaws Pursuit Race

### NOTICE OF RACE

Saturday March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025

The Sausalito Yacht Club (SYC) invites Bay Sailors to come out for the annual “Jaws Pursuit Race.” The race consists of a single pursuit race in the central bay lasting about two hours and finishing off the deck of the Sausalito Yacht Club. A pursuit race has a staggered start with the slower boats starting first and the faster boats starting later. The start times are based on PHRF handicaps. Time on Distance corrections shall be used. The first boat to finish wins, the second to finish is second, and so on.

The late Bud Livingstone created this race to bring back the old club tradition of finishing races off the club deck. The “Jaws” perpetual trophy was also donated by Bud.

Entry to the race is open to all sailboats with a current PHRF handicapping certificate. A copy of your PHRF certificate must be received by the race committee or listed on the current YRA web site ([www.yra.org](http://www.yra.org)) to complete your registration. Yachts without a current certificate or YRA listing may have a PHRF number assigned at the discretion of the race committee.

**RULES:** The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) shall govern this Series.

There will be two PHRF divisions for scoring purposes, Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker.

The warning signal will be sounded at 1200.

Trophies will be awarded for each Division. The winners of each division will be eligible for the Jaws Perpetual Trophy.

Online entry is via the event website at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/29377>. Competitors may request a mail-in entry form at [race@sausalitoyachtclub.org](mailto:race@sausalitoyachtclub.org) or at the club. The Entry fee is waived for SYC club members and is \$35 for non-members.

To receive an individual start time, entries must be received, at the club or online, by 0800 hours on Friday March 28<sup>th</sup>. Late entries may be permitted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

Sailing Instructions with competitor start times will be posted on the club website and available at the club no later than Friday March 28<sup>th</sup> at 1600 hours. Results will be available after the race at the club and posted on the club’s race bulletin board and web site as soon as practical.

Limited hosted hors d'oeuvres and beverages will be provided for participants after the race. The Jaws Pursuit Race is part of other club activities for the day including a party with a band.
