NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)

1. Rules

1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and by US Sailing and the appropriate one-design class rules except as noted and changed by the Sailing Instructions.1.2. Each competitor sailing in One-Design classes shall wear a life jacket that is 100% dependent on foam for flotation and the appropriate size for the sailor, at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while adding and removing clothing.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1. The sailing instructions will be available no later than 1830 hrs on Thursday, March 6, 2025, at Regatta Network website: <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/29388</u> and they will be targeted to be posted at Sarasota Sailing Squadron (SSS) on the unofficial notice board located by the race office on Saturday, March 8, 2025 no later than 10:00am.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open to the following One-Design classes: Flying Scot, Sunfish, M15, ILCA 7, ILCA 6, ILCA 4, E Scow, MC Scow and Boat Share vessels including but not limited to American 18 and Hobie Waves.

3.2 The regatta is open to all PHRF vessels. Those without a current certificate listed at <u>https://www.westfloridaphrf.org/?page_id=101</u> will be assigned a PHRF Rating by the Organizer but will not be eligible for <u>SBYA Boat of the Year</u> scoring. PHRF CRUISER CLASS CRUISING SPINNAKERS: The Cruising Classes shall declare their intent to use a Cruising spinnaker by 1200 March 7, 2025 by email to <u>scorer@sarabayracing.com</u>. Use of a Cruising Spinnaker will result in a reduction in the non-spinnaker offset as noted in Appendix E – Cruising Class Rules. Your certificate must show your actual Cruising Sail measurements to qualify for use.

3.3 A minimum of 3 vessels required per class for a separate start (One Design).

3.4 The organizing authority reserves the right to group similar vessels together to form one or more classes.

3.5To be considered an entry in the event, a vessel shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

4. FEES AND REGISTRATION

4.2 Registration: \$10, please register early to help with course management.

4.3 Registration after 5pm on Friday, March 7, 2025, will be \$25.

4.4 Pot O' Gold Regatta Celebration (included in registration)

From 1530 to 1730, celebrate with Irish-themed post racing party, music, hors d'oeuvres, and beer, provided. A cash bar will be available. Bring a friend!! Included in regatta registration.

4.5 Spring Blossom Series Awards and Dinner (charge additional to registration)

(celebrating SSS, Snowbird, Cherry Pie, and Pot O' Gold sailors)

From 1800 to 2000, Surf and Turf Dinner, DJ music and dancing

Not included in regatta registration. Requires additional purchase.

Tickets will be sold on RecHub. Tickets must be purchased by end of the day March 2. Search RecHub to find purchase link.

5.MEASUREMENT

5.1 Each vessel must be compliant with current class measurement rules.

6. COMMUNICATION

6.1 The online official notice board is located at: <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/29234</u> and the unofficial notice board is located at the SSS pavilion outside the race office.

6.2.[DP] When permitted by class rules, all vessels in **PHRF class** shall carry a multi-channel VHF radio. On the water, the PHRF race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the sailing instructions.

6.3 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a vessel in **PHRF class** shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all vessels.

7.3 Pot O' Gold Awards follow racing under the Pavilion during the Pot O' Gold Regatta Celebration. Invite your family and friends to join us for the social.

8. VENUE

8.1 Racing will be in Sarasota Bay north of Sarasota Sailing Squadron.

9. COURSES

9.1 One Design classes will include windward/leeward, triangles, or any combination. The specific course options and their designations will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

9.2 All other classes may sail a course which may include the following marks: Sarasota Sailing Squadron compass-rose marks, Sarasota Bay governments marks and/or inflatable/drop marks.

10. THE START

10.1 The races for all PHRF classes will be fleet starts.

10.2 OCS PHRF vessels shall restart by rounding either end of the starting line – no dip restarts allowed.

11. SCORING

11.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

12. AWARDS

12.1 Awards will be given to top finishers in each class.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1 Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. 13.2 By taking part in any of the events covered by this notice of race, each competitor voluntarily assumes the risks associated with communicable disease including but not limited to Covid-19.
