

# Notice of Race C's the Day 2025 Harbor 20 Race and Seminar

## 1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

American Legion Yacht Club (ALYC), 215 15th St. Newport Beach CA 92663 is the organizing authority for C's the Day.

### 2. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

#### 3. Divisions

- 3.1 This event is open to Harbor 20 C Division sailors only.
- 3.2 A "C" Division sailor is any sailor who is <u>not</u> currently qualified in the Harbor 20 A or B Division, membership in the Harbor 20 Association is not required.

## 4. Mentorship

Boats wishing to have a mentor on board must contact the Race Committee Chair, Scott Barnes race@alvc.com at least seven days prior to the event to arrange a mentor.

## 5. ENTRIES AND FEES

- 5.1 Online entry is available at <a href="https://www.alyc.com">www.alyc.com</a> through Regatta Network.
- 5.2 The entry fee for the race is \$30.00 and you may enter at anytime prior to 0900 hrs race day, but early registration is encouraged.

### 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 Sailing Instructions (SI's) will be available no later than 1700 April 26th and will be posted to the ALYC's website www.alyc.com through Regatta Network.
- 6.2 A race packet including the SI's and Newport Harbor map will be available at the Skippers meeting/Seminar on April 27th

## 7. SCHEDULE

- 7.1 1000 1030 Check in at ALYC 215 15th St, Newport Beach
  - 1030 1200 Seminar Making your way around the race course
  - 1300 Scheduled First Warning (start of race)
  - 1500 Approximate end of racing, meet back at ALYC for Award presentation, discussion, food and prizes
- 7.2 Two random leg races are scheduled.
- 7.3 Any changes to the schedule will be posted by 1900 the day before the race on the ALYC website through Regatta Network.

## 8. PRIZES

8.1 Prizes for series first, second, and third place will be awarded.

## 9. COURSES TO BE SAILED

Random leg courses in Newport Harbor will be sailed and shown in the SI's.

## 10. SCORING

- 10.1 Boats shall be scored based on their finish place, using RRS Appendix A.
- 10.2 A boats series score shall be the combined score of both races
- 10.3 There will be no throw-outs, this modifies RRS Appendix A
