Eligibility: This race is open to all boats with a PHRF number.

Racing Rules: This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2025-2028, this Notice of Race except as any of these are modified by the current version of the Canyon Lake Sailing Instructions, and if sailing in a one design fleet, the applicable fleet rules. This event is classified as a category "A" event. Any additional information will be posted on the Official Notice window of the Clubhouse.

Scoring:

Individual Race Champion: Each individual race is scored using the US Sailing Low point system. Boats that have not finished within one uncorrected hour of the first boat of their respective class, or not finished within 5 hours from their respective start (the maximum time limit) will be scored TLE.

Long Distance Series Championship: All nine scheduled races will be included in the yearlong Long Distance Series Championship using the High Point System:

LONG DISTANCE SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP HIGH POINT PERCENTAGE SYSTEM

FLEET ELIGIBILITY: An overall trophy will be awarded for each fleet where at least 5 eligible races are sailed and scored as a fleet. Yachts competing for an

overall award will be assigned to an eligible fleet, based on rating, by the race committee at the end of the racing season. Two otherwise ineligible fleets may be combined to form a single fleet, for the purpose of this award, at the discretion of the race committee.

RACE ELIGIBILITY: For inclusion in the overall scoring, a race must have a minimum of 3 finishers for the fleet. Yachts that do not comply with the event entry requirements (i.e. Complete form and pay fee) or do not start within 10 minutes of their scheduled start time are not considered entries.

1. RACES TO COUNT AND MINIMUM REQUIRED

To qualify for inclusion in the final series results a boat shall compete in (come to the starting area for) at least 75 percent of the eligible races.

2. RACE SCORES

Define 'N' to be the number of boats that compete in a particular race. Each boat finishing a race and not thereafter retiring, being penalized or given redress will be scored as follows:

| Finishing Place | Points |
|-----------------------|------------------|
| First | N |
| Second | N-1 |
| Third | N-2 |
| Fourth | N-3 |
| Each Place Thereafter | Subtract 1 point |

All other boats that compete in that race, including any that finish and thereafter retire or are disqualified, will score 0 points. Boats that do not compete in that race (DNC) will not be scored for the Long-Distance Series Championship.

3. SERIES SCORES

The series score for each boat will be a percentage calculated as follows: divide the sum of her race scores by the sum of the points she would have scored if she had placed first in every race in which she competed; multiply the result by 100. The qualified boat with the highest series score is the winner, and others are ranked accordingly. Each boat's best 5 scores will be included. An excluded race counts as a race to qualify a boat for a series score but not as one of her scored races

4. TIES AND OTHER RULES

Race ties will be scored using rule A7. Series ties will be broken using rule A8.1. Rules A1, A3, A5, A6, A9 and A10 also apply.

Proposed Classes: PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-Spinnaker, Open, and Trimaran with PHRF rating.

Races: Four races are scheduled. **You must register for each race date separately**

Courses: The race will be a Long-Distance Race. A pursuit start will be used with the highest PHRF rated boats starting first. The course and starting times will be distributed at the Super Dock. The course will depend on wind conditions, with distance to be set with the below “Target Finish Time” in mind.

Trophies:

Individual Races with Trophies.

The following Holiday Long-Distance Races have their own Trophies.

Fleet assignment is done by the Race Committee and announced prior to the race at the competitor’s meeting. The number of trophies by fleet is 1 – 3 boats = 1 trophy, 4 – 6 boats = 2 trophies, 7 or more boats = 3 trophies. All finishes will be posted on Regatta Network.

Long Distance Series Championship Trophies.

Each Fleet Champion (as determined by the high point system described above) is eligible for a Long Distance Series Championship Fleet Trophy.
