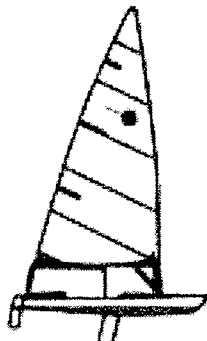
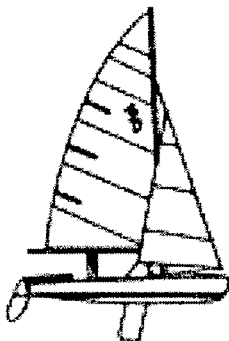

Authority: The Plymouth Yacht Club Junior Regatta (PYCJR) is organized under the authority of the Plymouth Yacht Club Regatta Committee and will be governed under the *Rules* as defined in "The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012," U.S. Sailing, U.S.O.D.A. Class Rules, Club 420 Class Rules, the Laser Class Rules, the Sailing Instructions, and any other applicable rules.

Entries: International Optimist Dinghy      Championship Line (White, Blue, and Red Fleets)  
Green Line (Novice Optimist Sailors Only)  
Club 420 Fleet                              420s and Lasers to run concurrently  
Laser    Full Rig only

Limitations: All competitors (skippers and crew) shall not have reached their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday during the 2011 calendar year.  
All competitors (skippers and crew) shall provide a release form for medical care, which must be signed by a parent or guardian if under 18 years of age.

Registration: Registration for this regatta may only be completed online at **Regatta Network**. ([www.regattanetwork.com](http://www.regattanetwork.com)). The entry fee is \$55.00 per person. A discount of \$15.00 will apply to those boats who register before 2400 hours on **Friday, August 5, 2011**. Online registration closes **Tuesday, August 9, 2011 at 1700 hours**.  
Entry into the Regatta will be accepted the day of the event in person only.  
Payment of the entry fee is required at the time of entry.  
Missing items will render the registration incomplete.

The registration package includes the following:

1. Online Registration / SMSA Medical Form / Boat Compliance Form through Regatta Networks (<http://www.regattanetwork.com/html/newcal.php>)
2. \$55.00 payment per person – (includes on-the-water lunch, BBQ after, T-shirt)
3. Sailing instructions will be distributed the day of the race.

Scoring: The Low-point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A2 will apply.  
One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.  
A boat's series score will exclude her worst race score if five or more races are completed.

Prizes: Awards for the first three places in each fleet as well as an overall award for Opti Championship Fleet.

Coach boats: All visiting coach and support boats are required to check in before heading out onto the water. Boats can be launched at the club or the town dock at the head of the harbor.  
Each coach boat shall have a working VHF radio, an anchor suitable for anchoring in the waiting area, and a basic first aid kit.  
No coaching is allowed after the first gun.

VHF: The committee boats will be monitoring channel 72

A BBQ will be provided to all participating sailors, coaches and parents after the race.
