



# AMENDMENT #1 TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Add [DP] to SI 3, Code of Conduct.

2. Replace SI 6.2 with:

6.2 The format of each event is shown in SI Addendum D, Format and Scoring.

6.2.1 The Fleet Series Stage for the Men's One Person Dinghy event (Laser) will be split into two fleets in accordance with SI 25.8.

6.2.2 For the Fleet Series Stage, the Men's Two Person Dinghy and the Women's Two Person Dinghy (470) events will be sailed and scored together as a single fleet.

3. Replace SI 7.5 with:

7.5 For the Men's One Person Dinghy event (Laser) and the Women's One Person Dinghy event (Laser Radial), the Fleet Series Stage will take place from Monday, January 28 to Wednesday, January 30, the Gold Stage will take place from Thursday, January 31 to Friday, February 1 and the Medal Stage, if held, will take place on Saturday, February 2. The qualifying series will be extended if four races for all fleets have not been completed.

4. Replace SI 7.8 with:

7.8 On the last scheduled day of racing for an event, no warning signal will be made after 1700.

5. SI 8 and 9 are intentionally blank.

**6. Replace SI 12.1 with:**

12.1 Marks 1, 2, 3, and 4, or associated gate marks, will be as follows:

**And add 12.6:**

12.6 For all Paralympic Events, if an inflatable Starting Mark is used, it will be an orange cylinder.

**7. Replace 14.3 with:**

14.3 [DP] **When a starting sequence is in progress**, boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area. The starting area is defined as a rectangle 50 meters from the starting line and marks in all directions.

**8. Change in 17 Time Limits and Target Times:**

The Finish Window for the Boards events is changed to 15 minutes.

**9. Replace 25.3 with:**

25.3 RRS A4.2 is changed so that those scores are based on  
(a) the number of boats assigned to compete in a **fleet**, for single fleets.  
(b) the number of boats assigned to the largest fleet in that stage, for split fleets **per SI 25.8**.

**10. Replace 25.9.1 with:**

The boats assigned to compete in the Medal Stage, and the boards assigned to compete in the Finals, will be ranked highest in the regatta. In events with more than two stages, the boats or boards assigned to a later stage will be ranked higher in the regatta than boats or boards assigned to an earlier stage. This instruction does not apply to a boat or board disqualified under RRS 5 or RRS 69.

**11. Replace 25.9.3 with:**

If there is a series-score tie at the end of medal stage, the tie will be broken by the score in the last race of the medal stage. If this does not resolve a tie, the tie will be broken by their ranking in the previous stage. This changes RRS A8.

**12. Replace the beginning of 26.9 with:**

On the last day of a **stage for an event**, a request ...

**15. Replace the Note 10 in ADDENDUM D with:**

Note 10: First boat to win 2 races, wins the event and the event is complete. 1st place in the Carryover Race counts as the first win. **The other boats will be ranked in accordance with A2. This changes the last sentence of RRS A2.**
