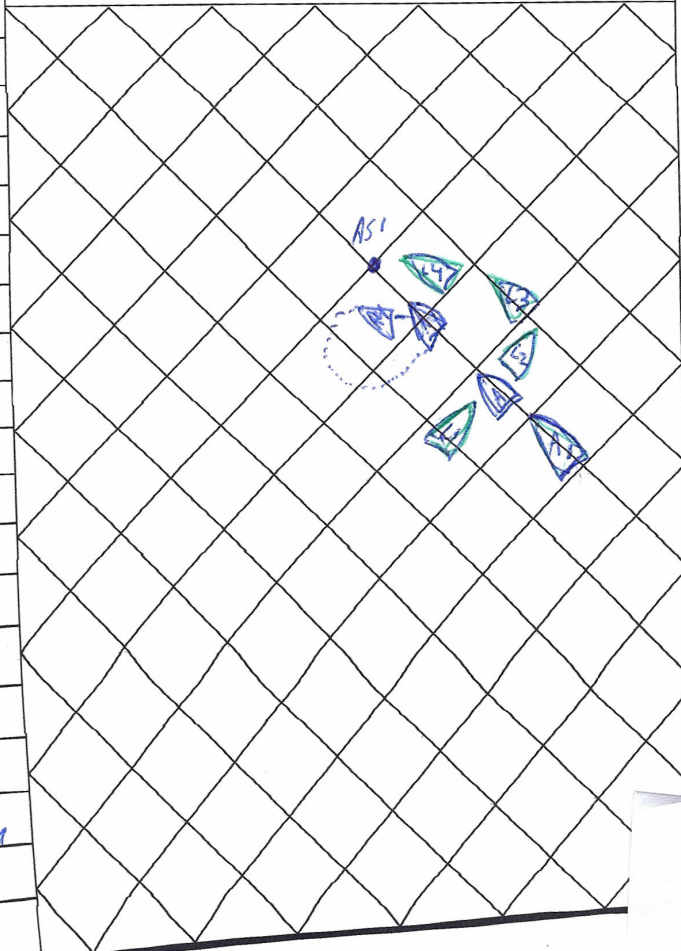
LOCHAN ORA ON PORT TACK CLEAR AHEAD (A2)

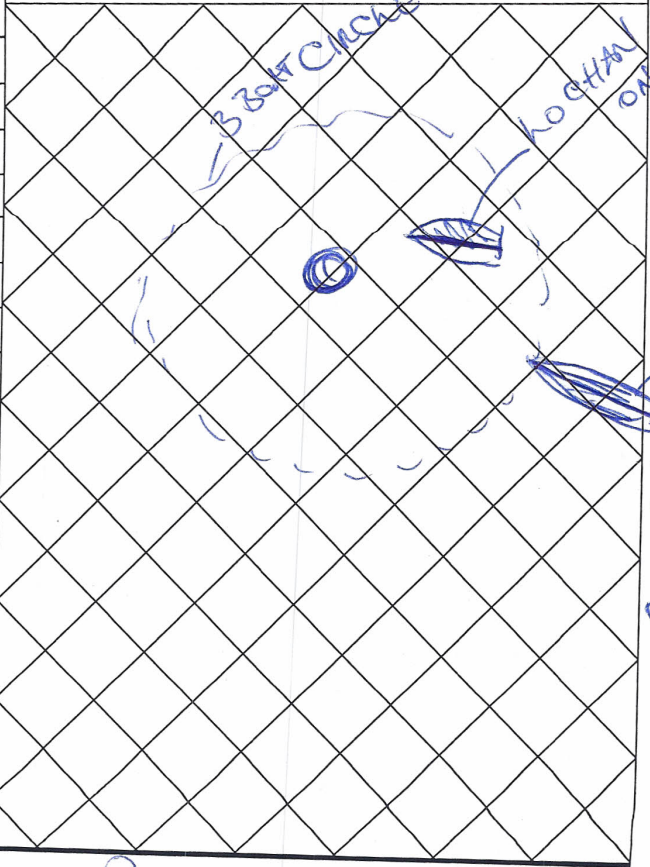

FACTS FOUND

1. **A & LO were beating on port tack to AS#1 a windward mark to be rounded to port.**
2. **A tacked to stbd 5 boat lengths to the mark and was fetching.**
3. **LO on port crossed ahead of A.**
4. **LO passed head to wind at 2 boat lengths from the mark and bore off directly to the mark.**
5. **A established an overlap to leeward from clear astern and sailed on the lay line to the mark.**
6. **LO passed the mark with three feet of space between her and the mark.**
7. **A altered course to avoid LO and the mark.**

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

1. **LO was required by RRS 18.3 to give A mark room and failed to do so.**
2. **LO was required by RRS 11 to keep clear and failed to do so.**
