11.2 Replace “a staff displaying a red/orange shape/flag” with “a red/orange buoy attached to”

New 11.2: The starting line will be between a red/orange buoy attached to the Race Committee boat and the course side of the mark as described in instruction 9.4.

Amendment #2 to the Sailing Instructions

8.2 (a) Add: If an “X” is displayed next to the standard course number, and additional AC leg will be sailed.

Amendment #3 to the Sailing Instructions

8.2 (b) A “G” will not be displayed on the committee boat. If the gate is present on the course it will be sailed as a gate. If the gate is not present the leeward mark must be left to port.
