Notice of Race Kaneohe Rum Run

Saturday & Sunday, August 3 & 4, 2013
Organizing Authority: Hawaii Yacht Club (HYC)

1. RULES

- 1.1. The race will be conducted according to *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016*, including the US Sailing Prescriptions, Hawaii Yacht Racing Association [HYRA] Prescriptions and HYC Standing Sailing Instructions for Offshore Races unless otherwise amended in this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing Rules of Sailing [RRS] 51 and 52 are modified to allow the use of integrally designed Canting Ballast Twin Foil [CBTF] and water ballast technology.
- 1.3. RRS 52 is modified to allow the use of winches operated using stored power.
- 2. <u>ADVERTISING</u> shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20. Competitor advertising will not be restricted.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all yachts that meet requirements for ISAF Offshore Special Regulations Category 4 and are members of HYRA member clubs, and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authority.
- 3.2. Eligible yachts may enter via the US Sailing RegattaNetwork website between July 4, 2013 and August 2, 1600 hrs. Entries will only be accepted using the RegattaNetwork website. http://www.regattanetwork.com/html/calendar.html

4. FEES

- 4.1. The entry fee is \$50.
- 4.2. "Kaneohe Special" \$30 entry fee for the Saturday race only (Waikiki to Kaneohe).
- 4.3. US Sailing members will receive a \$5 discount.
- 4.4. Late entries will be assessed an additional fee of \$10.

6. MEASUREMENTS & HANDICAPS

6.1. Each boat shall have a valid Performance Handicap Racing Fleet [PHRF] handicap certificate or be assigned a temporary handicap.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at the skippers' meeting, on the RegattaNetwork website, and on the HYC website immediately after the Skipper's Meeting.

8. MOORING

Mooring will be available at KYC for all race participants at no additional charge.

9. COURSE

The course is a distance race in the waters between Waikiki and Kaneohe Bay.

10. SCORING

- 10.1.Corrected times will be calculated using the PHRF Time-on-Time scoring system, as adopted by HYRA.
- 10.2. The low point system of RRS Appendix A shall apply without modification.

11. PRIZES

For each class, first prize will be awarded if at least three boats enter, second prize will be awarded if at least five boats enter, and third prized will be awarded if at least seven boats enter.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone. The organizing authority will not accept liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per event or the equivalent.
