Notice of Race 2013 OAR RACE FHYC New Bern, NC

Regatta: This is the 30th Oar Race Regatta. It is a feeder race from New Bern to Oriental for the Michelob Ultra Cup, which is scheduled on Sunday Sept.1st. Participation in the Michelob Ultra Cup is not required. The Oar Race commemorates the evacuation of Dunkirk and the perpetual award is an oar used during that historic event. The overall winner will have their name added to the perpetual trophy and receive a miniature replica.

Rules: The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. A violation of rule 55 can result in a penalty other then disqualification.

Eligibility and Entry: Fairfield Harbour Yacht Club is the organizing authority. The race is open to all monohull sailboats with a NC-PHRF rating. Entry is via online registration at www.regattanetwork.com/event/7131

Classes: Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker. Further division based on number of entries at Race Committee's discretion.

Schedule: Aug.31st. Skipper's meeting will be held at Northwest Creek marina at 8:30AM. The first warning signal is scheduled for 11:AM. There will be a cash bar social at the Tiki Bar at the Oriental Marina. Dinner: 6:30PM Awards 7:30PM

Course: One race. Start will be set in the vicinity of Neuse River markers #17 and #19 and Broad Creek #2. The finish will be set at Oriental marker #1.

Scoring: Race will be scored using time on time handicapping. For the purpose of determining the overall winner of the Oar Race, non-spinnaker boats will receive a 15 seconds per mile allowance on their handicap. This allowance will be applied by the race committee.

Radio Communication: The race committee may use VHF channel 67 to advise competitors.

Awards: Up to three trophies will be awarded to each division depending on the number of entries.

Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4. Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
